About Get Covered Illinois

- Get Covered Illinois is the Official Health Marketplace for Illinois residents.
- At **GetCoveredIllinois.gov**, you can take the first step to finding the health coverage option that is best for you and your budget.
- All plans offered through the Marketplace will cover important benefits like doctor's visits, hospital stays, prescriptions and more.
- Enrollment takes place from October 1, 2013 through March 31, 2014. If you enroll before December 15, coverage begins on January 1.

About Financial Help

- Most residents will get help paying for their plan. Individuals earning up to \$45,960 a year and families of four with annual income up to \$94,200 may be eligible for a tax credit to help pay for health coverage purchased through the Marketplace. Many will also receive discounts on their out-of-pocket costs for care and more residents will be eligible for low-cost or free health insurance through Medicaid.
- Small business owners with fewer than 25 employees can get a tax credit to help cover the cost of providing health insurance to their workers.

About Enrollment Assistance

- You can talk to someone in-person or over the phone about your options for free.
- Trained counselors, called Navigators, are available throughout the state to talk with you about your health coverage options and help you find the best plan for you and your family.
