Franklin Park Police Department Releases Independence Day Enforcement Numbers

Drive Sober or Get Pulled Over, Drive High Get a DUI

(Franklin Park, IL.) – Franklin Park Police Department made three (3) impaired driving arrests and issued twenty-eight (28) seat belt citations during the recent Independence Day "Drive Sober or Get Pulled Over," "Drive High Get a DUI" and "Click It or Ticket" safety campaigns. Additional activity included two (2) citations for speeding, seven (7) citations for distracted driving, eight (8) citations for driving without a valid or with a suspended/revoked license, and sixty-five (65) citations for other offenses.

Franklin Park Police joined forces with more than 200 other state and local law enforcement agencies to get drunk and drugged drivers off our roads, encourage seat belt use, and enforce speeding and other traffic laws. The effort featured high-visibility enforcement combined with a variety of outreach activities including the "It's Not a Game" media campaign.

The enforcement period was funded by federal traffic safety funds administered by the Illinois Department of Transportation as part of the statewide "Drive Sober or Get Pulled Over," "Drive High Get a DUI" and "Click It or Ticket" programs.
