Dear Neighbor,

The Village staff and personnel would like to wish you and your family a happy and healthy Holiday Season and a Merry Christmas.

We are still accepting your ideas for cutting our budget and streamlining our expenditures. The Village still must make significant cuts to balance its budget.

As I indicated last month, the Village has been over spending each year since 2002. This year's deficit is \$2.5 million. This deficit has not been caused by a downturn in the economy. The deficits will not disappear when the economy recovers. Next year we will face the same problem. One time, short-term gimmicks will not cure long term overspending. Grants from the state and federal government are for specific projects. By law, they cannot be used for operating expenses like salaries, pensions and healthcare. To put the Village on firm financial footing, significant, permanent cuts must be made.

In the coming weeks and months, we will be making changes in our spending habits based upon the Village's needs and your recommendations, to keep Franklin Park moving forward and financially strong.

May the spirit of this Holiday Season and the spirit of goodwill towards your fellow brothers and sisters, brought forth to this nation by our forefathers many years ago, light this time of year with the values we mutually cherish.

Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program

Beginning on December 2nd on Wednesday evenings from 4:00 p.m. - 6:30 p.m. at the Village Hall, 9500 W. Belmont Ave. Franklin Park; income eligible residents may fill out an application and file for help with winter home heating bills through the Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP).

LIHEAP provides a one-time payment to the utility companies on behalf of recipients. LIHEAP is available to seniors, along with persons and/or households with disabled members who receive SSI and SSDI benefits.

Please bring the following documents in order to file for benefits: Social Security card, a photo ID card, current NICOR bill, current COM ED bill, proof of gross income for 30 days, including your 2009 Social Security letter.
