Dear Neighbor,

For at least six of the last seven years, your village has spent more money than it has received in revenues. Given the current economic challenges and the difficulties many homeowners are experiencing in making mortgage payments and paying real estate taxes, it would be unfair to raise taxes. Your village has to learn to live within its means as you do with your family budget.

Over the next weeks and months, your village is going to make significant reductions in operating expenses. These reductions should be accomplished with your input. After all, they are your tax dollars. Please send us your suggestions for reductions in expenditures. Your ideas will be considered, we hope to implement as many as are practicable and reasonable.

There are some things you can do to help which are easy and obvious. Recycle more of your garbage. Paper, cardboard, glass bottles or jars, plastic, aluminum cans, mail, six and twelve pack rings, newspaper, magazines, telephone directories, brown paper bags, paperboard and chipboard (cereal boxes), and wet strength cardboard (beverage cartons) that you put into your recycling bin, reduces the village costs for putting your garbage into a land fill. Due to escalating landfill costs, the village is \$1 million dollars over budget on waste removal. If you recycle everything but your food garbage, you reduce costs to the village and reduce your own costs.

I will be providing more news on cost savings and reductions in upcoming newsletters.

Working together, our goal is to reduce the \$8.7 million debt we have been left with. I hope I can count on your help.

Helpful Reminders this winter season

The upcoming winter season will soon be upon us and Village would like to pass along some very helpful winter tips and reminders to make your holiday season an enjoyable one.

Fall leaf pickup

It is important to remember as the leaves fall they need to be placed in the brown biodegradable bags. Allied Waste will be unable to pickup the leaves if they are placed in plastic garbage bags. Please remember to place your bags out on garbage day with your garbage and recycling. Allied Waste will continue to pickup yard waste and leaves until December 2nd. In addition, the Street Department would like to remind residents not to place leaves in the street, as the leaves will block storm sewers and prevent rain water from running off.

Snow plowing

Once the snow begins to fall, our plow trucks will be on the road making our streets safe for travel. To make their jobs and your travel easier, we are asking that all residents follow the parking instructions on the blue snow route signs. This will allow our plow trucks to clean the streets quickly and avoid receiving a ticket for snow route parking violations.

Street sweeping continues

With the cold weather, leaves falling, and even some snow, it is easy to forget street sweeping continues through December 4th. We ask that all residents continue to follow the street sweeping route signs for parking on the streets until street sweeping operations have ended for the year.

Christmas at Hammill Square

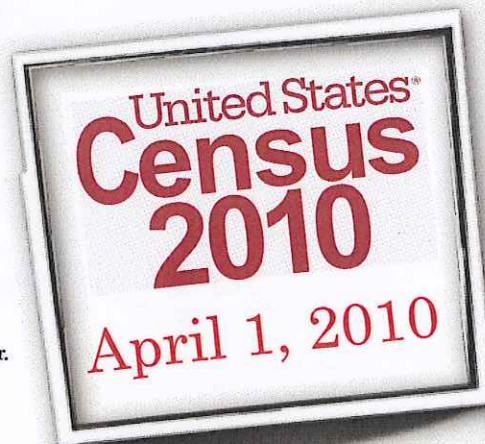
