The Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (IEPA) has made a tentative determination to issue a NPDES permit to discharge into the waters of the state and has prepared a draft permit and associated fact sheet for the above named discharger. The Public Notice period will begin and end on the dates indicated in the heading of this Public Notice/Fact Sheet. The last day comments will be received will be on the Public Notice period ending date unless a commentor demonstrating the need for additional time requests an extension to this comment period and the request is granted by the IEPA. Interested persons are invited to submit written comments on the draft permit to the IEPA at the above address. Commentors shall provide his or her name and address and the nature of the issues proposed to be raised and the evidence proposed to be presented with regards to those issues. Commentors may include a request for public hearing. Persons submitting comments and/or requests for public hearing shall also send a copy of such comments or requests to the permit applicant. The NPDES permit and notice number(s) must appear on each comment page.

The application, engineer's review notes including load limit calculations, Public Notice/Fact Sheet, draft permit, comments received, and other documents are available for inspection and may be copied at the IEPA between 9:30 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. Monday through Friday when scheduled by the interested person.

If written comments or requests indicate a significant degree of public interest in the draft permit, the permitting authority may, at its discretion, hold a public hearing. Public notice will be given 45 days before any public hearing. Response to comments will be provided when the final permit is issued. The applicant is engaged in operation of a railroad, including light railcar maintenance, fueling of locomotives, and switching and terminal operations (SIC 4011 and 4013). Plant operation results in an intermittent discharge of stormwater runoff from the southeast yard from outfall 002, an intermittent discharge of stormwater runoff from outfall 003, an intermittent discharge of stormwater runoff from the east yard from outfall 028, an intermittent discharge of stormwater runoff from outfall 029, and an intermittent discharge of stormwater runoff from the west yard from outfall 030.

The following modification is proposed:

Removing outfall 001 and adding two new stormwaters outfalls, 003 and 004.

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Application is made for the existing discharges which are located in Cook & DuPage County, Illinois. The following information identifies the discharge point, receiving stream and stream classifications:

To assist you further in identifying the location of the discharge please see the attached map.

The stream segment GM-01 receiving the discharge from outfalls 002, 003, 004, 028, and 029 are not on the 2010 303(d) list of impaired waters and are not a biologically significant stream.

The stream segment GLA-04 receiving the discharge from outfall 030 is on the 2010 303(d) list of impaired waters and is a biologically significant stream.

The following parameters have been identified as the pollutants causing impairment:

Alpha - BHC, alteration in streamside of littoral vegetative covers, aquatic algae, copper, hexachlorobenzene, other flow regime altercations, dissolved oxygen, phosphorus (total), polychlorinated biphenyls, sedimentation/siltation, and total suspended solids
