Franklin Park Police Department Releases Labor Day Enforcement Numbers

Franklin Park, Illinois – Franklin Park Police made three (3) impaired driving arrests and issued twenty-two (22) seat belt citations during its Labor Day traffic safety enforcement effort.

Additionally seventeen (17) citations were issued for various other traffic offenses, one driver was cited for Driving While License Revoked, and two arrests were made for misdemeanor criminal offenses.

Franklin Park PD joined forces with more than 200 other local law enforcement agencies from August 20 through September 7 to get drunk and drugged drivers off our roads and encourage seat belt use. The effort featured high-visibility enforcement combined with a variety of outreach activities, including a media campaign.

The Labor Day "Drive Sober or Get Pulled Over" campaign is funded by federal traffic safety funds from the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration and administered through the Illinois Department of Transportation.
