### **“Independence Day Traffic Safety Enforcement” Results Are In:**

**Franklin Park, Illinois** – Results are in from the *Drive Sober or Get Pulled Over Independence Day Traffic Safety Enforcement Campaign*.

During the Independence Day Traffic Safety Campaign, reducing the deadly dangers from drunk drivers and occupant protection was a top priority as the Franklin Park Police Department conducted saturation patrols, to arrest those who put themselves and others on the road at risk.

On June 25 through July 2, 2018 Franklin Park Police conducted roving saturation patrols between the hours of 10:00pm and 2:00am, looking for drunk drivers and those drivers and passengers not wearing seat belts. Officers came in contact with 105 vehicles and issued a total of 71 citations. Out of the 71 citations issued, 2 arrests were made for DUI, 2 arrests were made for driving while license suspended or revoked and 1 arrest was made more Fleeing and Eluding. 22 citations were issued for seat belt violations, 3 were for uninsured motor vehicles, 4 were for speeding and 37 other traffic violations were observed and citations issued.

The recent law enforcement crackdown was funded by federal traffic safety funds through the Illinois Department of Transportation and is part of the *Drive Sober or Get Pulled Over and Click It or Ticket* campaigns.
