Independence Day Traffic Enforcement Crackdown Results In Safer Streets over Holiday Weekend

Franklin Park, Illinois – Results are in from the Independence Day Traffic Enforcement Campaigns crackdown on Occupant Protection and Drunk Drivers.

During the Independence Day Holiday, reducing the deadly dangers from drunk drivers was a top priority for the Franklin Park Police Department. Officers were out in full force to arrest drivers who put themselves and others on the road at risk.

From June 23 to July 6, 2014, the Franklin Park Police stopped and arrested five drunk drivers, apprehended two fugitives and three Suspended/Revoked drivers, issued three Seat Belt Citations and issued multiple citations which included speeding violations, vehicle equipment violations, insurance violations and two citations, for possession of a controlled substance.

The recent law enforcement crackdown was funded by federal traffic safety funds through the Illinois Department of Transportation and is part of the *Drive Sober or Get Pulled Over and Click It or Ticket* campaigns.
