The Village of Franklin Park will launch its own Farmer's Market this summer, on the first and third Saturday of the month, from June through September. # **Community Notes**

**Franklin Ave Railroad Bridge** Please note that repair of the Franklin Avenue Rail Road Bridge at Wolf Road will force a single lane of traffic on Franklin Ave causing delays to last through the end of this year.

**Railroad Crossing Closing** Canadian Pacific Rail will be closing the railroad crossing at 25th Avenue (Rose) from Monday, June 20th through Sunday, July 3rd, to replace sections of the tracks. The closing should take approximately 14 days to complete, but could run over a couple of days due to weather or train traffic.

**Bi-Weekly Branch Pick-up Has Begun** Branch pick-up will take place every other week for the next several months. Residents should put all reasonably-sized branches in a neat stack, with the cut-end toward the curb, by Monday morning of the pick-up week and branches will be picked up sometime by the end of Friday. Place branches where you have regular garbage pick-up. The Village will remove branches resulting from regular tree trimming and will remove chopped-up small trees, but cannot remove large trees. Also, shrubs will be picked up but the root ball must be removed and put in a separate pile or placed in yard waste bags. Pick-up is scheduled for the weeks of June 6 & 20, July 5 & 18, August 1, 15 & 29, September 12 & 26, October 10 & 24 and November 7 & 21. For more information, call 847-671-8252.

**Mylar Balloons Can Gause Power Outages** ComEd warns to always keep Mylar balloons tethered to stop them from making contact with electrical lines and causing a surge of electricity, damaging equipment and resulting in power outages, fires and possible injuries. Metallic balloons have caused outages affecting 35,000 customers in 2010. If a balloon becomes entangled in an overhead power line, don't attempt to retrieve it. Instead, call ComEd at 800-334-7661. Always assume power lines are live, and stay 10 feet away from power lines.

**New Address for Utility Bill Payments** 

Beginning with May's utility bills, the Village of Franklin Park began using a new processing center located in Carol Stream. As a result, mailed utility bill payments should now be sent to the following address: Village of Franklin Park Utilities, PO Box 4593, Carol Stream IL 60197-4593. This new address is printed on the return envelope included in your bill.

In addition, you can still put utility bill payments in the deposit drop box at Village Hall or you can make payments in person at Village Hall during our regular hours of operation. If you have any questions regarding payment of utility bills, please call (847) 671-8252.
