# AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER TWO OF TITLE FOUR OF THE VILLAGE CODE OF THE VILLAGE OF FRANKLIN PARK, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS (AMENDING DEFINITION OF PRIVATE SCAVENGER)

WHEREAS, the Village of Franklin Park, Cook County, Illinois (the "Village") is a duly organized and existing municipal corporation created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois and under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code, as from time to time supplemented and amended; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Franklin Park (the "Corporate Authorities") may from time to time amend the text of the Village Code of Franklin Park when it is determined to be in the best interests of the residents of the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities find that it is in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of its citizenry to amend the definition of "*Private Scavenger*" in order to provide consistency throughout the Village Code of Franklin Park.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Franklin Park, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

**Section 1**. That the above recitals are found to be true and correct and are hereby incorporated herein and made a part hereof, as if fully set forth in their entirety.

Section 2. Section 1 ("Definitions") of Article A ("Scavengers") of Chapter 2 ("Garbage and Waste") of Title 4 ("Public Health and Welfare") of the Village Code of Franklin Park is hereby amended by deleting the following stricken language and adding the underlined language to read, as follows:

#### 4-2A-1: DEFINITIONS:

For the purpose of this Article, the following words and phrases shall have the meaning ascribed to them:

OFFAL SCAVENGER: Any person engaged in the business of collecting, gathering or transporting butchers' offal, calfskins, hotel or restaurant bones, grease, glue, stock or kindred refuse, by wagon, cart or otherwise, or to drive any wagon or vehicle for such purpose through the public ways of the village.

PRIVATE SCAVENGER: Any person, firm, corporation, partnership or other entity engaged in the business of removal for purposes of recycling or remanufacture, and/or removal and disposal of any table refuse or animal and vegetable matter usually known as garbage or recyclable materials, scrap metal, plastics, yard waste, commercial or trade waste, from stores, offices, industries, manufacturers, hotels, restaurants, cafes, boarding houses or all other places not otherwise provided for in this code and/or the removal and disposal of ashes and cinders, and/or the removal and disposal of manure, swill or any animal or vegetable refuse and wastes, including decaying animal matter and fish from commission houses or other places where such decaying animal matter and fish may accumulate.

PRIVATE SCAVENGER: Any person, firm or corporation engaged in the removal of solid waste, compostable material and/or recyclable material from any location within the Village not covered by either an exclusive collection contract between the Village and a contracted hauler or a franchise agreement between the village and a franchised hauler.

SEWER AND CATCH BASIN CLEANER: Any person engaged in the business of cleaning, collecting or transporting the contents of catch basins or sewers by vehicle or otherwise, or in any way engaged in the business of cleaning catch basins and sewers; provided, that licensed plumbers or licensed sewer builders who may clean catch basins or sewers as an incident to the repair of such catch basins or sewers shall not be included in such definition.

**Section 3**. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any other provision of this Ordinance.

**Section 4**. All ordinances, resolutions, motions or orders in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

**Section 5**. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Franklin Park, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

**Section 1**. That the above recital is found to be true and correct and is hereby incorporated herein and made a part hereof, as if fully set forth in its entirety.

Section 2. This Ordinance is and shall be designated as "The Annual Tax Levy Ordinance of the Village of Franklin Park, Cook County, Illinois" for the Fiscal Year beginning May 1, 2012 and ending April 30, 2013.

Section 3. The total amount of appropriations for all corporate purposes, legally made to be collected from the property tax levy of the current year is ascertained to be the sum of \$10,827,550.00.

Section 4. The purpose of which appropriations are made and the amount appropriated for each purpose, respectively, to be collected for the Tax Levy of the current year are, as follows (see attachment):

There is hereby certified to the County Clerk of Cook County, Illinois, the several sums aforesaid, constituting the total amount of \$10,827,550.00, which said total amount the Village of Franklin Park, Cook County, Illinois requires to be raised by taxation for the current municipal fiscal year (May 1, 2012 to April 30, 2013) of said Village, and the Village Clerk is hereby directed to file within the time required by law, a certified copy of this Ordinance and also to certify within said mentioned time to said County Clerk the total amount required to be raised by taxation; as aforesaid, in accordance with the provision of the revenue laws of the State of Illinois.

**Section 6.** If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any other provision of this Ordinance.

**Section 7**. All ordinances, resolutions, motions or orders in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

**Section 8**. This Ordinance is declared to be urgent and necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety of the general public and shall, therefore, take effect and be in full force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Village President.

In addition, Customer agrees that this license is limited to applications for its own use and may not lease or rent the Service(s) nor offer its use for others. All Customer data is owned by the Customer. Under no circumstances is the system intended to capture confidential information of any kind. Confidential information is defined as social security numbers and financial information.

Customer agrees to maintain the Authorized Website(s) identified in Schedule A, provide WEBQA with all information reasonably necessary to setup or establish the Service(s) on Customer's behalf, and allow a "Powered by GovQA" logo with a hyperlink to WebQA's website home page on the Authorized Website.

#### 3. SERVICE(S) LEVELS:

WEBQA will use commercially reasonable efforts to backup and keep the Service(s) and Authorized Website(s) in operation consistent with applicable industry standards and will respond to customers' requests for support during normal business hours.

THE SERVICE(S) ARE PROVIDED ON AN "AS IS" BASIS, AND CUSTOMER'S USE OF THE SERVICE(S) IS AT ITS OWN RISK. WEBQA DOES NOT WARRANT THAT THE SERVICE(S) WILL BE UNINTERRUPTED OR ERROR-FREE OR UNEFFECTED BY FORCE MAJEURE EVENTS.
