



Section 3. The Village President and Village Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to execute and deliver the Agreement and any and all other documents necessary to implement the

provisions, terms and conditions thereof, as therein described, subject to the prior execution of the Agreement by representatives of the International Association of Firefighters, Local 1526.

Section 4. The officials and officers of the Village are hereby authorized to undertake actions on the part of the Village as contained in the Agreement to complete satisfaction of the provisions, terms or conditions stated therein.

Section 5. The Village Comptroller and Village Treasurer are hereby authorized and directed to expend such necessary funds and undertake such financial action on the part of the Village as contained in the Agreement to complete satisfaction of any provision, term or condition stated therein.

Section 6. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Resolution shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any other provision of this Resolution.

**Section** 7. All ordinances, resolutions, motions or orders in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

**Section 8**. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.

#### Park District of Franklin Park and Village of Franklin Park Special Event Lead/Support Agreement

The Village of Franklin Park and the Park District of Franklin Park have successfully worked together to provide annual special events for their residents. These events have been entertaining and enjoyable, and at the same time, a great example of two government agencies cooperating on behalf of taxpayers. In an effort to provide the most effective delivery of these services, both agencies are agreeing for the calendar year 2013 to the following:

The Village and the Park District will continue to offer six jointly sponsored events. For each event one agency will take the role of lead agency and the other the role of support agency. The Village will be the lead agency for Christmas at Hammill Square, Railroad Daze, and the Car Show. The Park District will be lead agency for Street Dance, Foundation Five K Race and the Eddie Biondo Fall Fest Parade.

The lead agency for each event will be responsible for:

- 1. Selecting the date and location
- Selecting food vendors, entertainment, bands
- Developing the major promotional materials (special posters and flyers, press releases, newspaper
- Ordering physical requirements (staging, lighting, tents, tables, chairs, port-o-lets)
- Providing event staffing
- Disbursing payment to contractors, etc. (excludes personnel costs incurred by the support agency)
- Scheduling joint meetings to plan and evaluate events
- Providing adequate insurance coverage for their role in the event
- Preparing and distributing financial and evaluation reports on each event

The support agency for each event will be responsible for:

- 1. Using existing means to cross-promote the event (Park District brochure & newsletter, marquee sign, Village newsletter)
- 2. Providing staffing (parks staff, recreation staff, public works staff, police officers)
- 3. Providing agency-owned equipment and supplies
- 4. Providing adequate insurance coverage for their role in the event
- 5. Sending appropriate staff to attend planning meetings
- 6. Assisting in any other way that is mutually agreed upon

#### **Event Schedules**

The Village of Franklin Park and Park District agree to set event dates no later than December 1, for the following year.

This agreement is in effect for calendar year 2013 after which it will be reviewed and evaluated for 2014.

(3)	To attend conferences at any reasonable time when requested to do so by representatives of the LA or the Department.
(4)	In the event plans or surveys are found to be in error during construction of the SECTION and revisions of the plans or survey corrections are necessary, the ENGINEER agrees that he will perform such work without expense to the LA, even though final payment has been received by him. He shall give immediate attention to these changes so there will be a minimum delay to the Contractor.
(5)	That basic survey notes and sketches, charts, computations and other data prepared or obtained by the Engineer pursuant to this AGREEMENT will be made available, upon request, to the LA or the DEPARTMENT without cost and without restriction or limitations as to their use.
(6)	That all plans and other documents furnished by the ENGINEER pursuant to this AGREEMENT will be endorsed by him and will show his professional seal where such is required by law.

1.	To pay the ENGINEER as compensation for all services performed as stipulated in paragraphs 1a, 1g, 1i, 2, 3, 5 and 6 in accordance with one of the following methods indicated by a check mark:
	a. A sum of money equal to percent of the awarded contract cost of the proposed improvement as approved by the DEPARTMENT.
	b. A sum of money equal to the percent of the awarded contract cost for the proposed improvement as approved by the DEPARTMENT based on the following schedule:

2.	To pay for services stipulated in paragraphs 1b, 1c, 1d, 1e, 1f, 1h, 1j & 1k of the ENGINEER AGREES at actual cost of performing such work plus percent to cover profit, overhead and readiness to serve - "actual cost" being defined as material cost plus payrolls, insurance, social security and retirement deductions. Traveling and other out-of-pocket expenses will be reimbursed to the ENGINEER at his actual cost. Subject to the approval of the LA, the ENGINEER may sublet all or part of the services provided under the paragraph 1b, 1c, 1d, 1e, 1f, 1h, 1j & 1k. If the ENGINEER sublets all or part of this work, the LA will pay the cost to the ENGINEER plus a five (5) percent service charge.  "Cost to Engineer" to be verified by furnishing the LA and the DEPARTMENT copies of invoices from the party doing the work. The classifications of the employees used in the work should be consistent with the employee classifications for the services performed. If the personnel of the firm, including the Principal Engineer, perform routine services that should normally be performed by lesser-salaried personnel, the wage rate billed for such services shall be commensurate with the work performed.

- 3. That payments due the ENGINEER for services rendered in accordance with this AGREEMENT will be made as soon as practicable after the services have been performed in accordance with the following schedule:
  - a. Upon completion of detailed plans, special provisions, proposals and estimate of cost being the work required by paragraphs 1a through 1g under THE ENGINEER AGREES to the satisfaction of the LA and their approval by the DEPARTMENT, 90 percent of the total fee due under this AGREEMENT based on the approved estimate of cost.
  - b. Upon award of the contract for the improvement by the LA and its approval by the DEPARTMENT, 100 percent of the total fee due under the AGREEMENT based on the awarded contract cost, less any amounts paid under "a" above.

By Mutual agreement, partial payments, not to exceed 90 percent of the amount earned, may be made from time to time as the work progresses.

- 4. That, should the improvement be abandoned at any time after the ENGINEER has performed any part of the services provided for in paragraphs 1a, through 1h and prior to the completion of such services, the LA shall reimburse the ENGINEER for his actual costs plus \_5 \_\_\_\_ percent incurred up to the time he is notified in writing of such abandonment -"actual cost" being defined as in paragraph 2 of THE LA AGREES.
- 5. That, should the LA require changes in any of the detailed plans, specifications or estimates except for those required pursuant to paragraph 4 of THE ENGINEER AGREEs, after they have been approved by the DEPARTMENT, the LA will pay the ENGINEER for such changes on the basis of actual cost plus \_\_\_\_\_\_ percent to cover profit, overhead and readiness to serve -"actual cost" being defined as in paragraph 2 of THE LA AGREES. It is understood that "changes" as used in this paragraph shall in no way relieve the ENGINEER of his responsibility to prepare a complete and adequate set of plans and specifications.

#### It is Mutually Agreed,

- 1. That any difference between the ENGINEER and the LA concerning their interpretation of the provisions of this Agreement shall be referred to a committee of disinterested parties consisting of one member appointed by the ENGINEER, one member appointed by the LA and a third member appointed by the two other members for disposition and that the committee's decision shall be final.
- 2. This AGREEMENT may be terminated by the LA upon giving notice in writing to the ENGINEER at his last known post office address. Upon such termination, the ENGINEER shall cause to be delivered to the LA all surveys, permits, agreements, preliminary bridge design & hydraulic report, drawings, specifications, partial and completed estimates and data, if any from traffic studies and soil survey and subsurface investigations with the understanding that all such material becomes the property of the LA. The ENGINEER shall be paid for any services completed and any services partially completed in accordance with Section 4 of THE LA AGREES.
- 3. That if the contract for construction has not been awarded one year after the acceptance of the plans by the LA and their approval by the DEPARTMENT, the LA will pay the ENGINEER the balance of the engineering fee due to make 100 percent of the total fees due under this AGREEMENT, based on the estimate of cost as prepared by the ENGINEER and approved by the LA and the DEPARTMENT.
- 4. That the ENGINEER warrants that he/she has not employed or retained any company or person, other than a bona fide employee working solely for the ENGINEER, to solicit or secure this contract, and that he/she has not paid or agreed to pay any company or person, other than a bona fide employee working solely for the ENGINEER, any fee, commission, percentage, brokerage fee, gifts or any other consideration, contingent upon or resulting from the award or making of this contract. For Breach or violation of this warranty the LA shall have the right to annul this contract without liability.

WHEREAS, the Village of Franklin Park, Cook County, Illinois (the "Village") is a duly organized and existing municipal corporation created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois and under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code, as from time to time supplemented and amended; and

WHEREAS, the President and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Franklin Park (the "Corporate Authorities") have heretofore exercised the power conferred on them pursuant to Chapter 11-13-1, et seq., of the Illinois Municipal Code by adopting the Franklin Park Zoning Ordinance in 1974 (Ord. 7475 Z10), as amended from time to time; and

WHEREAS, a conditional use application, ZBA 13-02, has been submitted to the Village by Roxana Ventura (the "Applicant") to allow within the C-2-2 Central Business District the operation of a Restaurant use (the "Proposed Conditional Use") on the property commonly known as 3019 Rose St., Franklin Park, Illinois (the "Property"); and

WHEREAS, the Zoning Board of Appeals held a public hearing on March 13, 2013 on whether the Proposed Conditional Use should be approved, at which time all persons present were afforded an opportunity to be heard; and

WHEREAS, a public notice in the form required by law was given of said public hearing dates; and

WHEREAS, the Zoning Board of Appeals has filed its findings of fact and recommendations that the Proposed Conditional Use be granted, and the Corporate Authorities

have duly considered said findings of fact and recommendations; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities have determined, in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village, to grant the Proposed Conditional Use subject to the conditions identified herein.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Franklin Park, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

**Section 1.** The above recitals and legislative findings are found to be true and correct and are hereby incorporated herein and made a part hereof, as if fully set forth in their entirety.

Section 2. The President and the Board of Trustees hereby adopt by reference the findings of fact of the Zoning Board of Appeals as findings of the President and the Board of Trustees as if completely set forth herein. All documents and exhibits submitted at the aforesaid public hearings are also incorporated by reference into this Ordinance.

**Section 3.** In addition to the findings set forth in Section 2 hereof, the President and the Board of Trustees further finds in relation to the Proposed Conditional Use as follows:

- 1. The establishment, maintenance or operation of the Proposed Conditional Use, subject to the conditions set forth herein, will not be detrimental to, or endanger the public health, safety, morals, comfort, or general welfare;
- 2. The Proposed Conditional Use, subject to the conditions set forth herein, will not be injurious to the use and enjoyment of other property in the immediate vicinity for the purposes already permitted, nor substantially diminish and impair property values within the neighborhood;
- 3. The Proposed Conditional Use, subject to the conditions set forth herein, will not impede the normal and orderly development of the surrounding property for uses permitted in the C-2-2 Central Business District;
- 4. The Proposed Conditional Use, subject to the conditions set forth herein, will not affect the exterior architectural appeal and functional plan of structures already constructed as to cause a substantial depreciation in property values within the neighborhood as the proposed plans will be an improvement upon the existing

structure;

- 5. Adequate utilities, access roads, drainage and necessary facilities for the Proposed Conditional Use are already in place at the Property;
- 6. Ingress and egress for the Proposed Conditional Use, subject to the conditions set forth herein, shall minimally affect traffic congestion in the public streets;
- 7. The Proposed Conditional Use shall, in all other respects, conform to the applicable regulations of the C-2-2 Central Business District.

**Section 4.** A Conditional Use, subject to the conditions set forth below, is hereby granted and issued for the operation of a Restaurant use in the C-2-2 Central Business District located at 3019 Rose St., Franklin Park, Illinois, and which is legally described as follows:

LOTS 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21 AND 22 IN BLOCK 8 IN FRANKLIN PARK, BEING A SUBDIVISION OF THE WEST ½ OF THE NORTHWEST ¼ OF SECTION 27, TOWNSHIP 40 NORTH, RANGE 12 EAST OF THE THIRD PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN, IN COOK COUNTY.

This conditional use permit is subject to the following conditions:

- 1. That an opaque privacy fence, no less than 6 feet nor more than 8 feet in height, be installed along the eastern boundary of the Property;
- 2. That use of the drive-thru window at the Property is strictly prohibited, unless approved by the Zoning Board of Appeals after submission of the appropriate application;
- 3. That the use of the Property complies with all other codes and ordinances of the Village of Franklin Park;

Section 8. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect following its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.

# AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF FRANKLIN PARK, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS, GRANTING A CONDITIONAL USE TO ALLOW A RESTAURANT USE IN THE C-2-1 COMMUNITY SHOPPING DISTRICT (ZBA 13-04: 9507 W. GRAND AVE.)

WHEREAS, the Village of Franklin Park, Cook County, Illinois (the "Village") is a duly organized and existing municipal corporation created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois and under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code, as from time to time supplemented and amended; and

WHEREAS, the President and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Franklin Park (the "Corporate Authorities") have heretofore exercised the power conferred on them pursuant to Chapter 11-13-1, et seq., of the Illinois Municipal Code by adopting the Franklin Park Zoning Ordinance in 1974 (Ord. 7475 Z10), as amended from time to time; and

WHEREAS, a conditional use application, ZBA 13-04, has been submitted to the Village by Nick Consention and Rick Heidner (the "Applicants") to allow within the C-2-1 Community Shopping District the operation of a Restaurant use (the "Proposed Conditional Use") on the property commonly known as 9507 W. Grand Ave., Franklin Park, Illinois (the "Property"); and

WHEREAS, the Zoning Board of Appeals held a public hearing on March 13, 2013 on whether the Proposed Conditional Use should be approved, at which time all persons present were afforded an opportunity to be heard; and

WHEREAS, a public notice in the form required by law was given of said public hearing dates; and

WHEREAS, the Zoning Board of Appeals has filed its findings of fact and

recommendations that the Proposed Conditional Use be granted, and the Corporate Authorities have duly considered said findings of fact and recommendations; and

**WHEREAS**, the Corporate Authorities have determined, in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village, to grant the Proposed Conditional Use subject to the conditions identified herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Franklin Park, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

- **Section 1.** The above recitals and legislative findings are found to be true and correct and are hereby incorporated herein and made a part hereof, as if fully set forth in their entirety.
- Section 2. The President and the Board of Trustees hereby adopt by reference the findings of fact of the Zoning Board of Appeals as findings of the President and the Board of Trustees as if completely set forth herein. All documents and exhibits submitted at the aforesaid public hearings are also incorporated by reference into this Ordinance.
- **Section 3.** In addition to the findings set forth in Section 2 hereof, the President and the Board of Trustees further finds in relation to the Proposed Conditional Use as follows:
  - 1. The establishment, maintenance or operation of the Proposed Conditional Use, subject to the conditions set forth herein, will not be detrimental to, or endanger the public health, safety, morals, comfort, or general welfare;
  - 2. The Proposed Conditional Use, subject to the conditions set forth herein, will not be injurious to the use and enjoyment of other property in the immediate vicinity for the purposes already permitted, nor substantially diminish and impair property values within the neighborhood;
  - 3. The Proposed Conditional Use, subject to the conditions set forth herein, will not impede the normal and orderly development of the surrounding property for uses permitted in the C-2-1 Community Shopping District;
  - 4. The Proposed Conditional Use, subject to the conditions set forth herein, will not affect the exterior architectural appeal and functional plan of structures already

constructed as to cause a substantial depreciation in property values within the neighborhood as the proposed plans will be an improvement upon the existing structure;

- 5. Adequate utilities, access roads, drainage and necessary facilities for the Proposed Conditional Use are already in place at the Property;
- 6. Ingress and egress for the Proposed Conditional Use, subject to the conditions set forth herein, shall minimally affect traffic congestion in the public streets;
- 7. The Proposed Conditional Use shall, in all other respects, conform to the applicable regulations of the C-2-1 Community Shopping District.

**Section 4.** A Conditional Use, subject to the conditions set forth below, is hereby granted and issued for the operation of a Restaurant use in the C-2-1 Community Shopping District located at 9507 W. Grand Avenue, Franklin Park, Illinois, and which is included within the following legal description:

THAT PART OF THE NORTHWEST ¼ OF THE NORTHWEST ¼ OF THE SOUTHWEST ¼ OF SECTION 27, TOWNSHIP 40 NORTH, RANGE 12, EAST OF THE THIRD PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN, LYING BETWEEN THE EAST LINE OF THE WEST 414.60 FEET AND THE WEST LINE OF THE EAST 680 FEET OF SAID ¼ ¼ SECTION; SOUTH OF A LINE 54 FEET SOUTHWESTERLY OF THE CENTER LINE OF GRAND AVENUE AND NORTH OF A LINE DRAWN AT RIGHT ANGLES TO THE WEST LINE THE EAST 680 FEET OF SAID NORTHWEST ¼ OF THE SOUTHWEST ¼ OF SECTION 27 WHICH IS 872.43 FEET NORTH OF THE SOUTH LINE OF SAID ¼ ¼ SECTION, EXCEPTING FROM ABOVE THE DESCRIBED TRACTS OF LANDS, THE WEST 18 FEET LYING BETWEEN 2 LINES DRAWN AT RIGHT ANGLES TO THE WEST LINE OF SAID TRACT THROUGH POINTS 283 FEET AND 313 FEET RESPECTIVELY, NORTH OF THE SOUTH WEST CORNER THEREOF, IN COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS.

This conditional use permit is subject to the following conditions:

- 1. That all employee parking shall occur on-site, off-site parking being strictly prohibited;
- 2. That the use of the Property complies with all other codes and ordinances of the Village of Franklin Park;

- 3. That this conditional use permit shall be limited to Nick Consentino and shall not be transferable except upon reapplication, hearing and approval in the manner provided in the Franklin Park Zoning Ordinance; and
- 4. This Ordinance shall be signed by the Applicant and owner of record to signify their agreement to the terms hereof.
- **Section 5.** The Applicants hereunder shall at all times comply with the terms and conditions of the conditional use and in the event of non-compliance, said permit shall be subject to revocation by appropriate legal proceedings.
- **Section 6.** If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any other provision of this Ordinance.
- **Section 7.** All ordinances, resolutions, motions or orders in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
- **Section 8.** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect following its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
