### ORDINANCE NUMBER 1314-G-\_

### THE ANNUAL TAX LEVY ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF FRANKLIN PARK, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING MAY 1, 2013 AND ENDING APRIL 30, 2014

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Franklin Park, Cook County, Illinois (the *AVillage @*) is a duly organized and existing municipal corporation created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois and under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code, as from time to time supplemented and amended.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Franklin Park, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

- **Section 1**. That the above recital is found to be true and correct and is hereby incorporated herein and made a part hereof, as if fully set forth in its entirety.
- **Section 2**. This Ordinance is and shall be designated as "The Annual Tax Levy Ordinance of the Village of Franklin Park, Cook County, Illinois" for the Fiscal Year beginning May 1, 2013 and ending April 30, 2014.
- **Section 3.** The total amount of appropriations for all corporate purposes, legally made to be collected from the property tax levy of the current year is ascertained to be the sum of \$11,072,418.00.
- **Section 4**. The purpose of which appropriations are made and the amount appropriated for each purpose, respectively, to be collected for the Tax Levy of the current year are, as follows (see attachment):

Section 5. There is hereby certified to the County Clerk of Cook County, Illinois, the several sums aforesaid, constituting the total amount of \$11,072,418.00, which said total amount the Village of Franklin Park, Cook County, Illinois requires to be raised by taxation for the current municipal fiscal year (May 1, 2013 to April 30, 2014) of said Village, and the Village Clerk is hereby directed to file within the time required by law, a certified copy of this Ordinance and also to certify within said mentioned time to said County Clerk the total amount required to be raised by taxation; as aforesaid, in accordance with the provision of the revenue laws of the State of Illinois.

**Section 6**. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any other provision of this Ordinance.

**Section 7**. All ordinances, resolutions, motions or orders in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

**Section 8**. This Ordinance is declared to be urgent and necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety of the general public and shall, therefore, take effect and be in full force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Village President.

#### ORDINANCE NUMBER 1314-Z-\_\_

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF FRANKLIN PARK, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS, GRANTING A CONDITIONAL USE TO ALLOW AN "OTHER MANUFACTURING, PROCESSING, STORAGE OR COMMERCIAL USE" IN THE C-M COMMERCIAL MANUFACTURING DISTRICT (ZBA 13-20: 9867 PACIFIC AVENUE)

WHEREAS, the Village of Franklin Park, Cook County, Illinois (the "Village") is a duly organized and existing municipal corporation created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois and under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code, as from time to time supplemented and amended; and

WHEREAS, the President and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Franklin Park (the "Corporate Authorities") have heretofore exercised the power conferred on them pursuant to Chapter 11-13-1, et seq., of the Illinois Municipal Code by adopting the Franklin Park Zoning Ordinance in 1974 (Ord. 7475 Z10), as amended from time to time; and

WHEREAS, a conditional use application, ZBA 13-20, has been submitted to the Village by Nikhil Mullick and Ingraffia-Gambino Investments (the "Applicants") to allow within the C-M Commercial Manufacturing District the operation of an "Other manufacturing, processing, storage or commercial" use in the nature of a hybrid business with a granite/stone showroom/warehouse and granite/stone fabrication (the "Proposed Conditional Use") on the property commonly known as 9867 Pacific Avenue, Franklin Park, Illinois and as legally described on Exhibit A (the "Property"); and

WHEREAS, the Zoning Board of Appeals held a public hearing on December 11, 2013 on whether the Proposed Conditional Use should be approved, at which time all persons present were afforded an opportunity to be heard; and

WHEREAS, a public notice in the form required by law was given of said public hearing dates; and

WHEREAS, the Zoning Board of Appeals has filed its findings of fact and recommendations that the Proposed Conditional Use be granted, and the Corporate Authorities have duly considered said findings of fact and recommendations; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities have determined, in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village, to grant the Proposed Conditional Use subject to the conditions identified herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Franklin Park, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

- **Section 1.** The above recitals and legislative findings are found to be true and correct and are hereby incorporated herein and made a part hereof, as if fully set forth in their entirety.
- Section 2. The President and the Board of Trustees hereby adopt by reference the findings of fact of the Zoning Board of Appeals as findings of the President and the Board of Trustees as if completely set forth herein. All documents and exhibits submitted at the aforesaid public hearings are also incorporated by reference into this Ordinance.
- **Section 3.** In addition to the findings set forth in Section 2 hereof, the President and the Board of Trustees further finds in relation to the Proposed Conditional Use as follows:
  - 1. The establishment, maintenance or operation of the Proposed Conditional Use, subject to the conditions set forth herein, will not be detrimental to, or endanger the public health, safety, morals, comfort, or general welfare;
  - 2. The Proposed Conditional Use, subject to the conditions set forth herein, will not be injurious to the use and enjoyment of other property in the immediate vicinity for the purposes already permitted, nor substantially diminish and impair property values within the neighborhood;

- 3. The Proposed Conditional Use, subject to the conditions set forth herein, will not impede the normal and orderly development of the surrounding property for uses permitted in the C-M Commercial Manufacturing District;
- 4. The Proposed Conditional Use, subject to the conditions set forth herein, will not affect the exterior architectural appeal and functional plan of structures already constructed as to cause a substantial depreciation in property values within the neighborhood as the proposed plans will be an improvement upon the existing structure;
- 5. Adequate utilities, access roads, drainage and necessary facilities for the Proposed Conditional Use are already in place at the Property;
- 6. Ingress and egress for the Proposed Conditional Use, subject to the conditions set forth herein, shall minimally affect traffic congestion in the public streets; and
- 7. The Proposed Conditional Use shall, in all other respects, conform to the applicable regulations of the C-M Commercial Manufacturing District.

Section 4. A Conditional Use, subject to the conditions set forth below, is hereby granted and issued for the operation of a "Other manufacturing, processing, storage or commercial" use in the nature of a hybrid business with a granite/stone showroom/warehouse and granite/stone fabrication use in the C-M Commercial Manufacturing District located at 9867 Pacific Ave., Unit A, Franklin Park, Illinois, and legally described as follows:

### SEE EXHIBIT A ATTACHED HERETO.

This conditional use permit is subject to the following conditions:

- 1. That the hours of operation of the Conditional Use shall be limited between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. Monday through Saturday and operations on Sunday shall be strictly prohibited;
- 2. That all employee parking shall occur on-site as off-site parking shall be strictly prohibited;
- 3. That all work and storage related to the Conditional Use shall occur indoors within the building located on the Property;
- 4. That the Conditional Use at the Property complies with all other codes and ordinances of the Village of Franklin Park;

- 5. That this Conditional Use shall be limited to Nikhil Mullick and shall not be transferable except upon reapplication, hearing and approval in the manner provided in the Franklin Park Zoning Ordinance; and
- 6. This Ordinance shall be signed by the Applicants to signify their acknowledgement of the terms hereof.

**Section 5.** The Applicants hereunder shall at all times comply with the terms and conditions of the conditional use and in the event of non-compliance, said permit shall be subject to revocation by appropriate legal proceedings.

**Section 6.** If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any other provision of this Ordinance.

**Section 7.** All ordinances, resolutions, motions or orders in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

**Section 8.** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect following its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
