ORDINANCE NUMBER 1314-G _____

AN ORDINANCE IMPOSING A NON-HOME RULE MUNICIPAL RETAILERS' OCCUPATION TAX AND NON-HOME RULE MUNICIPAL SERVICE OCCUPATION TAX IN THE VILLAGE OF FRANKLIN PARK, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, the Village of Franklin Park, Cook County, Illinois (the "*Village*") is a duly organized and existing municipal corporation created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois and under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code, as from time to time supplemented and amended; and

WHEREAS, 65 ILCS 5/8-11-1.1 empowers non-home rule municipalities with the authority, upon approval by referendum, to impose by ordinance the tax authorized in 65 ILCS 5/8-11-1.3 and 65 ILCS 5/8-11-1.4, which is commonly referred to and known as a local sales tax; and

WHEREAS, 65 ILCS 5/8-11-1.3 authorizes a non-home rule municipality to impose a Non-Home Rule Municipal Retailers' Occupation Tax upon all persons engaged in the business of selling tangible personal property, other than an item of tangible personal property which is titled and registered by an agency of the State of Illinois, at retail in the municipality; and

WHEREAS, 65 ILCS 5/8-11-1.4 authorizes a non-home rule municipality to impose a Non-Home Rule Municipal Service Occupation Tax upon all persons engaged in the business of making sales of service in the municipality; and

WHEREAS, the President and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Franklin Park passed Resolution Number 1314-R-17 on December 17, 2013, submitting to referendum for consideration by the electors of the Village at the March 18, 2014 election the proposition of imposing a Non-Home Rule Municipal Retailers' Occupation Tax and Non-Home Rule Municipal Service Occupation Tax; and

WHEREAS, on March 18, 2014, the referendum regarding the imposition of the Non-Home Rule Municipal Retailers' Occupation Tax and Non-Home Rule Municipal Service Occupation Tax was approved by a majority of the electors in the Village voting upon the question in the affirmative and a canvass of all votes cast for the referendum was undertaken by the office of the Cook County Clerk; and

WHEREAS, on April 8, 2014, Cook County Clerk David Orr issued the Official Certificate of Results wherein which it was determined that 63.24% of the votes cast in the March 18, 2014 election on the referendum were YES votes and that there were more YES votes than No votes, a copy of the Official Certificate of Results from the Cook County Clerk is attached hereto and made a part hereof as Exhibit A.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Franklin Park, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. That the above recitals and legislative findings are found to be true and correct and are hereby incorporated herein and made a part hereof, as if fully set forth in their entirety.

Section 2. Section 1-6-7, 1-6-8 and 1-6-9 of Chapter 6 ("*Taxes*") of Title 1 ("*Administrative*") of the Village Code of Franklin Park are hereby deleted in their entirety.

Section 3. Chapter 6 ("*Taxes*") of Title 1 ("*Administrative*") of the Village Code of Franklin Park is hereby amended by adding the following new underlined section to read, as follows:

1-6-7: NON-HOME RULE MUNICIPAL RETAILERS' OCCUPATION TAX AND NON-HOME RULE MUNICIPAL SERVICE OCCUPATION TAX:

A. Imposition of Non-Home Rule Municipal Retailers' Occupation Tax and Non-Home Rule Municipal Service Occupation Tax: A Non-Home Rule Municipal Retailers' Occupation Tax is hereby imposed upon all persons engaged in the business of selling tangible

personal property, other than an item of tangible personal property titled and registered by an agency of this State's government, at retail in the Village at the rate of one percent (1%) of the gross receipts from such sales made in the course of such business; and a Non-Home Rule Municipal Service Occupation Tax is hereby imposed upon all persons engaged in the Village in the business of making sales of service, at the rate of one percent (1%) of the selling price of all tangible personal property transferred by such servicemen as an incident to a sale of service. The Non-Home Rule Municipal Retailers' Occupation Tax and the Non-Home Rule Municipal Service Occupation Tax shall not be applicable to the sale of food for human consumption that is to be consumed off the premises where it is sold (other than alcoholic beverages, soft drinks and food that has been prepared for immediate consumption) and prescription and non-prescription medicines, drugs, medical appliances and insulin, urine testing materials, syringes and needles used by diabetics. The imposition of the Non-Home Rule Municipal Retailers' Occupation Tax and Non-Home Rule Municipal Service Occupation Tax herein are in accordance with the provisions of 65 ILCS 5/8-11-1.3 and 65 ILCS 5/8-11-1.4, respectively and as from time to time supplemented and amended.

B. *Collection; Payment and Enforcement:* The Non-Home Rule Municipal Retailers' Occupation Tax and Non-Home Rule Municipal Service Occupation Tax herein imposed shall be collected by the Department of Revenue of the State of Illinois in accordance with the provisions of this section and such additional statutory provisions and all civil penalties that may be assessed as an incident thereto shall be collected and enforced by the Department of Revenue of the State of Illinois. The Department of Revenue of the

State of Illinois shall have full power to administer and enforce the provisions of this section.

Section 4. The Village Clerk is hereby directed to file a certified copy of this Ordinance and the certification that the Ordinance received referendum approval immediately with the Illinois Department of Revenue.

Section 5. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any other provision of this Ordinance.

Section 6. All ordinances, resolutions, motions or orders in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 7. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage due to the urgent need of protecting the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village.
