WHEREAS, 65 ILCS 5/8-11-1.1 empowers non-home rule municipalities with the authority, upon approval by referendum, to impose by ordinance the tax authorized in 65 ILCS 5/8-11-1.3 and 65 ILCS 5/8-11-1.4, which is commonly referred to and known as a local sales tax; and

WHEREAS, 65 ILCS 5/8-11-1.3 authorizes a non-home rule municipality to impose a Non-Home Rule Municipal Retailers' Occupation Tax upon all persons engaged in the business of selling tangible personal property, other than an item of tangible personal property which is titled and registered by an agency of the State of Illinois, at retail in the municipality; and

WHEREAS, 65 ILCS 5/8-11-1.4 authorizes a non-home rule municipality to impose a Non-Home Rule Municipal Service Occupation Tax upon all persons engaged in the business of making sales of service in the municipality; and

WHEREAS, the President and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Franklin Park passed Resolution Number 1314-R-17, submitting to referendum for consideration by the electors of the Village at the March 18, 2014 election the proposition of imposing a Non-Home Rule Municipal Retailers' Occupation Tax and Non-Home Rule Municipal Service Occupation Tax; and

WHEREAS, on March 18, 2014, the referendum was approved by a majority of the electors in the Village voting upon the question in the affirmative and a canvass of all votes cast for the referendum was undertaken by the office of the Cook County Clerk; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Franklin Park adopted Ordinance Number 1314-VC-36 entitled “*An Ordinance Imposing a Non-Home Rule Municipal Retailers’ Occupation Tax and Non-Home Rule Municipal Service Occupation Tax in the Village of Franklin Park, Cook County, Illinois;*” and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Franklin Park may from time to time amend the text of the Village Code of Franklin Park when it is determined to be in the best interests of the residents of the Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Franklin Park, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. That the above recitals and legislative findings are found to be true and correct and are hereby incorporated herein and made a part hereof, as if fully set forth in their entirety.

Section 2. Section 1-6-7 (“*Non-Home Rule Municipal Retailers’ Occupation Tax and Non-Home Rule Municipal Service Occupation Tax*”) of Chapter 6 (“*Taxes*”) of Title 1 (“*Administrative*”) of the Village Code of Franklin Park is hereby amended by adding the following new underlined subsection to read, as follows:

1-6-7: NON-HOME RULE MUNICIPAL RETAILERS’ OCCUPATION TAX AND NON-HOME RULE MUNICIPAL SERVICE OCCUPATION TAX:

C. *Effective Date: The Non-Home Rule Municipal Retailers’ Occupation Tax and Non-Home Rule Municipal Service Occupation Tax herein imposed shall take effect on July 1, 2014.*

Section 3. The Village Clerk is hereby directed to file a certified copy of this Ordinance immediately with the Illinois Department of Revenue.

Section 4. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any other provision of this Ordinance.

Section 5. All ordinances, resolutions, motions or orders in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 6. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER EIGHT OF TITLE
SEVEN OF THE VILLAGE CODE OF THE VILLAGE
OF FRANKLIN PARK, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS
(PAYMENT OF WATER BILLS AND LIABILITY)

WHEREAS, the Village of Franklin Park, Cook County, Illinois (the "*Village*") is a duly organized and existing municipal corporation created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois and under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code, as from time to time supplemented and amended; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Franklin Park (the "*Corporate Authorities*") designate water regulations of the Village and are charged with the responsibility of periodically adjusting these regulations to address the changing needs of the Village and its residents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Franklin Park, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. That the above recitals and legislative findings are found to be true and correct and are hereby incorporated herein and made a part hereof, as if fully set forth in their entirety.

Section 2. Article B ("*Service Charges*") of Chapter 8 ("*Water Systems*") of Title 7 ("*Public Works and Properties*") of the Village Code of the Village of Franklin Park, Illinois, is hereby amended by deleting the following stricken language and adding the underlined language to read, as follows:

7-8B-6: PAYMENT OF BILLS; LIABILITY; DELINQUENCIES; COLLECTIONS; SHUT OFF.

A. All water and sewer bills shall be payable at the office of the village comptroller within twenty-one (21) days from the date of the bill. All bills paid after said twenty-one (21) day period shall be subject to a penalty of ten percent (10%) per month of the outstanding amount due.

B. The owner of the premises, the occupant thereof and the consumer of the water and/or sewer service shall be jointly and severally liable for payment of the service to such premises, and the service is only furnished to the premises by the Village upon the condition that the owner of the premises, the occupant thereof and the consumer of the service are jointly and severally liable therefore to the Village. The owner of any premises to which water and/or sewer service is rendered is liable to pay for such service and such service is to be provided by the Village, regardless of any separate private agreements that the owner may maintain with a third-party for liability. The owner of the premises is at all times required to notify the village of the billing address and such other information required by the Village regardless of any sale or transfer of the premises, or change in occupancy or consumer of water at the premises.

B.C. Water service shall ~~may~~ be terminated by the village comptroller or utilities commissioner when any bill for metered water service is more than ~~forty five (45)~~ sixty (60) days past due. The village comptroller or utilities commissioner shall notify such consumer of the past due billing by the mailing of a written notice of termination by certified mail to the billing address and to the owner of record, as referenced by the taxpayer's identification number. The consumer shall be given at least ten (10) days' written notice of intent to shut off such service, the reason for the shutoff, and an opportunity to request and obtain a hearing with respect to such unpaid charges before the village comptroller or utilities commissioner. If the village comptroller or utilities commissioner confirms the shutoff, the consumer shall be allowed a reasonable period of time, not less than five (5) days, to pay the delinquent charges prior to the shutoff of services.

At least ten (10) days prior to shutting off the service, a tag notice shall be posted at the premises warning that the service will be shut off. Water service, which has been shut off, shall not be resumed until all bills, late charges and penalties have been paid. It shall be the duty of the village comptroller to enforce the provisions of this section whenever delinquency shall occur. Therefore, ten (10) days after such ~~notification-notice of termination~~ is mailed and after the village posts a tag notice on the premises where service is received or five (5) days after the hearing with the village comptroller or utilities commissioner wherein service shutoff was confirmed, service shall be terminated.

Where service is terminated, the consumer may obtain water service by the payment of the past due bill, including interest and penalties, if any, plus a charge of ~~one hundred dollars (\$100.00)~~ two-hundred and fifty dollars (\$250.00) for shutting off and opening of such service. The utilities commissioner shall be authorized to waive said charge, if it is determined that extenuating or emergency circumstances exists.

€ D. Whenever a bill for water or sewer service remains unpaid for more than ~~forty-five (45)~~ sixty (60) days after its due date, the village comptroller or utilities commissioner may record a lien claim for the amount due (including any penalty and interest) against the property in question. The village attorney is authorized to institute foreclosure proceedings in the name of the village against any property against which a lien has been recorded. The Village may also enforce collection of delinquent water bills by filing civil proceedings in the Circuit Court of Cook County. Such proceeding may be against the owner of the premises for which the water was supplied or any tenant, lessee, occupant or consumer who contracted for such water or against both of them.

Ð E. Whenever the village comptroller or utilities ~~director~~ commissioner determines that a given ~~eustomer's~~ party's water or sewer account is in arrears, the village comptroller or utilities ~~director~~ commissioner is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with such ~~eustomer~~ party to avoid termination of service.

1. Such agreement may create payment plans designed to allow such ~~eustomer~~ party to pay over time past due amounts for service received. The village comptroller or utilities ~~director~~ commissioner is authorized to waive outstanding late fees and penalties accrued on such ~~eustomer's~~ party's account for those ~~eustomer's~~ party's who enter into an agreement. At a minimum, such agreement must provide that all bills for future service will be paid in full on time and that the arrears agreed amount will be paid in full. Such agreement shall provide terms for the repayment of the arrears agreed amount in installments for a specified period, require a minimum good faith down payment of the outstanding balance and provide for a mechanism to enforce the collection of unpaid balances, including the recording of a lien on the property in question.

2. In the event a ~~eustomer~~ party fails to abide by the terms of such agreement, the outstanding balance and all late fees and penalties become due and the village comptroller or utilities ~~director~~ commissioner shall terminate service ~~following~~ after the fifth tenth (10th) day after the village posts a tag notice of termination on the premises where service is received and the mailing of written notice of termination ~~to such eustomer~~ by certified mail at such eustomer's to the billing address and to the owner of record, as referenced by the taxpayer's identification number.

Section 3. Section 7-8B-7 ("*Lien Against Premises for Enforcement*") of Article B ("*Service Charges*") of Chapter 8 ("*Water Systems*") of Title 7 ("*Public Works and Properties*") of the Village Code of the Village of Franklin Park, Illinois, is hereby amended by deleting the following stricken language and adding the underlined language to read, as follows:

7-8B-7: LIEN AGAINST PREMISES FOR ENFORCEMENT.

In addition to any other remedy provided for the enforcement or collection of any water rent or rate, all rates provided for in this article shall be a lien against the premises to which any water may be supplied and charged against the owner thereof; and each property owner of rented buildings in the village shall be responsible to the village for all charges for village water used therein, or on or about the grounds adjacent thereto in any action waged by the village in any court of competent jurisdiction for the amount of all water rents or rates as may be due and unpaid, together with all penalties provided in this article, reasonable attorney fees and costs. Any change of ownership or occupancy shall not affect the application of this section. At no time shall the non receipt of a bill exempt the owner of the premises, the occupant thereof and the consumer of the water and/or sewer service to such premises from any responsibility or liability imposed in this Chapter.

The village clerk comptroller or utilities commissioner is hereby authorized and directed to file sworn statements showing such delinquencies in the office of the recorder of deeds of Cook County in accordance with 65 ILCS 5/11-139-8; and the filing of such statements shall be deemed notice of the lien for the payment of such charges for water and sewerage services. Failure to record such lien claim shall not affect the right to foreclose the lien for a delinquency.

The village attorney shall have the power to foreclose on such lien in a like manner and with like effect as set forth under 65 ILCS 5/11-139-8.

Section 4. Article A (*“Permit for Water Connection and Use”*) of Chapter 8 (*“Water Systems”*) of Title 7 (*“Public Works and Properties”*) of the Village Code of the Village of Franklin Park, Illinois, is hereby amended by adding the new underlined language to read, as follows:

7-8A-1: PERMIT REQUIRED; TRANSFER:

Any person desiring to make any connection with the water system or plant or use water therefrom shall first obtain a permit for such purpose.

Whenever the consumer and/or owner of the village water services intends to cease using such services, due to moving or other reasons, said consumer and/or owner must notify the village of the day he intends to cease using water services. Notification may be made to the village utilities department in writing, which department shall record such notification in the ordinary course of business. The village will then perform a final reading of the meter and bill the user accordingly.

To transfer billing of water services to a new user when no transfer of ownership is anticipated, the

new user must notify the billing department. Regardless of any such notification, however, the owner of the premises will remain liable for any water services used prior to the conveyance of the title to the property.

Section 5. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any other provision of this Ordinance.

Section 6. If any part of this Ordinance is found to be in conflict with any other ordinance, resolution, motion or order or parts thereof, the most restrictive or highest standard shall prevail.

Section 7. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.

~~The total number of class D liquor licenses shall not exceed two (2).~~

The total number of class D liquor licenses shall not exceed one (1).

~~The total number of class B liquor licenses shall not exceed nine (9).~~

The total number of class B liquor licenses shall not exceed ten (10).

Section 3. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any other provision of this Ordinance.

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Franklin Park (the "*Corporate Authorities*") regulate the number of liquor licenses that are available for the sale and distribution of alcoholic beverages with the Village; and

WHEREAS, JNCC, Incorporated d/b/a All Star Wings is not operational at the premises located at 9505 Grand Avenue, Franklin Park, Illinois, and is no longer eligible for use of a Class D2 Liquor License.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Franklin Park, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. That the above recitals and legislative findings are found to be true and correct and are hereby incorporated herein and made a part hereof, as if fully set forth in their entirety.

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Franklin Park (the "*Corporate Authorities*") may from time to time amend the text of the Village Code of Franklin Park to determine the composition and structure of the Fire Department when it is in the best interests of the residents of the Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Franklin Park, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. That the above recitals and legislative findings are found to be true and correct and are hereby incorporated herein and made a part hereof, as if fully set forth in their entirety.

Section 2. Section 1-5G-1 ("*Established; Composition*") of Article G ("*Fire Department*") of Chapter 5 ("*Village Departments*") of Title 1 ("*Administrative*") of the Village Code of Franklin Park, Illinois, is hereby amended by deleting the following stricken language and adding the underlined language to read, as follows:

1-5G-1: ESTABLISHED; COMPOSITION:

There shall be and is hereby created and established a fire department consisting of a regular full time chief, three (3) battalion chiefs, ~~twelve (12)~~ nine (9) regular full time lieutenants, provided that the decrease in the number of full time lieutenants from twelve (12) to nine (9) shall only be eliminated through attrition and that all persons holding the rank of full time lieutenants on May 31, 2014, shall maintain such rank until their date of retirement or other termination of their employment with the village's fire department, twenty five (25) regular full time firefighters, one clerk, and such other on call members of the fire department as may from time to time be determined by the president and board of trustees, who shall be elected or appointed as herein provided. Battalion chiefs on each shift shall be designated by the fire chief as a battalion chief, and the persons occupying the positions of battalion chief shall be supervisors, as per 5 Illinois Compiled Statutes 315/3(r). Firefighter candidates at the time of application shall be ~~EMT/A~~ EMT/P trained certified, or thereafter receive such training and certification before their appointment can become effective, as determined necessary by the board of fire and police commissioners, based upon departmental needs. Firefighters certified as paramedics (EMT/P) may allow for that certification to terminate, provided they retain certification as an EMT/A. ~~Additionally, there may be designated from the positions described above no more than three (3) individuals to provide services as mechanics.~~

The rank of captain has been eliminated through attrition. All persons holding the rank of captain on April 30, 2001, shall maintain such rank until their date of retirement or other termination of their employment with the village's fire department. No other persons shall hereafter be promoted to the rank of captain.

Section 3. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any other provision of this Ordinance.

Section 4. All ordinances, resolutions, motions or orders in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.

WHEREAS, a conditional use application, ZBA 14-06, has been submitted to the Village by Kenneth Kwiat, Jr. and Thomas Paoli (the "*Applicants*") to allow within the C-M Commercial Manufacturing District the operation of a "Contractor and Construction Yard and Office" use (the "*Proposed Conditional Use*") on the property commonly known as 10170 Franklin Avenue, Franklin Park, Illinois and as legally described on Exhibit A (the "*Property*"); and

WHEREAS, the Zoning Board of Appeals held a public hearing on March 5, 2014 and May 7, 2014 on whether the Proposed Conditional Use should be approved, at which time all persons present were afforded an opportunity to be heard; and

WHEREAS, a public notice in the form required by law was given of said public hearing

dates; and

WHEREAS, the Zoning Board of Appeals has filed its findings of fact and recommendations that the Proposed Conditional Use be denied, and the Corporate Authorities have duly considered said findings of fact and recommendations; and

Section 1. The above recitals and legislative findings are found to be true and correct and are hereby incorporated herein and made a part hereof, as if fully set forth in their entirety.

Section 2. The President and the Board of Trustees hereby adopt by reference the findings of fact of the Zoning Board of Appeals as findings of the President and the Board of Trustees as if completely set forth herein. All documents and exhibits submitted at the aforesaid public hearings are also incorporated by reference into this Ordinance.

Section 3. In addition to the findings set forth in Section 2 hereof, the President and the Board of Trustees further finds in relation to the Proposed Conditional Use as follows:

1. The establishment, maintenance or operation of the Proposed Conditional Use will be detrimental to, or endanger the public health, safety, morals, comfort, or general welfare;
2. The Proposed Conditional Use will be injurious to the use and enjoyment of other property in the immediate vicinity for the purposes already permitted, and will substantially diminish and impair property values within the neighborhood;
3. The Proposed Conditional Use will impede the normal and orderly development of the surrounding property for uses permitted in the C-M Commercial Manufacturing District;

4. The Proposed Conditional Use will affect the exterior architectural appeal and functional plan of structures already constructed as to cause a substantial depreciation in property values within the neighborhood;
5. Adequate utilities, access roads, drainage and necessary facilities for the Proposed Conditional Use are not in place at the Property; and
6. Ingress and egress for the Proposed Conditional Use shall negatively affect traffic congestion in the public streets.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF FRANKLIN PARK,
COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS, GRANTING A CONDITIONAL USE
TO ALLOW A "RESTAURANT" USE WITHIN
THE C-2-1 COMMUNITY SHOPPING ZONING DISTRICT
(ZBA 14-07: 9505 GRAND AVENUE)

WHEREAS, the Village of Franklin Park, Cook County, Illinois (the "*Village*") is a duly organized and existing municipal corporation created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois and under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code, as from time to time supplemented and amended; and

WHEREAS, the President and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Franklin Park (the "*Corporate Authorities*") have heretofore exercised the power conferred on them pursuant to Chapter 11-13-1, *et seq.*, of the Illinois Municipal Code by adopting the Franklin Park Zoning Ordinance in 1974 (Ord. 7475 Z10), as amended from time to time; and

WHEREAS, a conditional use application, ZBA 14-07, has been submitted to the Village by Everardo Ruelas and Rick Heidner (the "*Applicants*") to allow within the C-2-1 Community Shopping Zoning District the operation of a "Restaurant" use (the "*Proposed Conditional Use*") on the property commonly known as 9505 Grand Avenue, Franklin Park, Illinois and as legally described on Exhibit A (the "*Property*"); and

WHEREAS, the Zoning Board of Appeals held a public hearing on May 7, 2014 on whether the Proposed Conditional Use should be approved, at which time all persons present were afforded an opportunity to be heard; and

WHEREAS, a public notice in the form required by law was given of said public hearing dates; and

WHEREAS, the Zoning Board of Appeals has filed its findings of fact and recommendations that the Proposed Conditional Use be granted, and the Corporate Authorities have duly considered said findings of fact and recommendations; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities have determined, in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village, to grant the Proposed Conditional Use subject to the conditions identified herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Franklin Park, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. The above recitals and legislative findings are found to be true and correct and are hereby incorporated herein and made a part hereof, as if fully set forth in their entirety.

Section 2. The President and the Board of Trustees hereby adopt by reference the findings of fact of the Zoning Board of Appeals as findings of the President and the Board of Trustees as if completely set forth herein. All documents and exhibits submitted at the aforesaid public hearings are also incorporated by reference into this Ordinance.

Section 3. In addition to the findings set forth in Section 2 hereof, the President and the Board of Trustees further finds in relation to the Proposed Conditional Use as follows:

1. The establishment, maintenance or operation of the Proposed Conditional Use, subject to the conditions set forth herein, will not be detrimental to, or endanger the public health, safety, morals, comfort, or general welfare;
2. The Proposed Conditional Use, subject to the conditions set forth herein, will not be injurious to the use and enjoyment of other property in the immediate vicinity for the purposes already permitted, nor substantially diminish and impair property values within the neighborhood;
3. The Proposed Conditional Use, subject to the conditions set forth herein, will not impede the normal and orderly development of the surrounding property for uses permitted in the C-2-1 Community Shopping Zoning District;

4. The Proposed Conditional Use, subject to the conditions set forth herein, will not affect the exterior architectural appeal and functional plan of structures already constructed as to cause a substantial depreciation in property values within the neighborhood as the proposed plans will be an improvement upon the existing structure;
5. Adequate utilities, access roads, drainage and necessary facilities for the Proposed Conditional Use are already in place at the Property;
6. Ingress and egress for the Proposed Conditional Use, subject to the conditions set forth herein, shall minimally affect traffic congestion in the public streets; and
7. The Proposed Conditional Use shall, in all other respects, conform to the applicable regulations of the C-2-1 Community Shopping Zoning District.

Section 4. A Conditional Use, subject to the conditions set forth below, is hereby granted and issued for the operation of a "Restaurant" use in the C-2-1 Community Shopping District located at 9505 Grand Avenue, Franklin Park, Illinois, and legally described as follows:

THAT PART OF THE NORTHWEST QUARTER OF THE SOUTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 27, TOWNSHIP 40 NORTH, RANGE 12, EAST OF THE THIRD PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN, LYING BETWEEN THE EAST LINE OF THE WEST 414.50 FEET AND THE WEST LINE OF THE EAST 68 FEET OF SAID QUARTER SECTION, SOUTH OF A LINE 54 FEET SOUTHWESTERLY OF THE CENTER LINE OF GRAND AVENUE AND NORTH OF A LINE DRAWN AT RIGHT ANGLES TO THE WEST LINE OF THE EAST 680 FEET OF SAID NORTHWEST QUARTER OF THE SOUTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 27 WHICH IS 872.43 FEET NORTH OF THE SOUTH LINE OF SAID QUARTER SECTION, EXCEPTING FROM ABOVE THE DESCRIBED TRACTS OF LANDS, THE WEST 18 FEET LYING BETWEEN 2 LINES DRAWN AT RIGHT ANGLES TO THE WEST LINE OF SAID TRACT THROUGH POINTS 283 FEET AND 313 FEET RESPECTIVELY, NORTH OF THE SOUTHWEST CORNER THEREOF, IN COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS.

This conditional use permit is subject to the following conditions:

1. That signage be prominently displayed at the front of the Property, and of a size reasonably calculated to notify customers, indicating that additional parking related to the Conditional Use is available in the rear of the property;
2. That the Conditional Use at the Property complies with all other codes and ordinances of the Village of Franklin Park;
3. That this Conditional Use shall be limited to Everardo Ruelas and shall not be transferable except upon reapplication, hearing and approval in the manner provided in the Franklin Park Zoning Ordinance; and
4. This Ordinance shall be signed by the Applicants to signify their acknowledgement of the terms hereof.

Section 5. The Applicants hereunder shall at all times comply with the terms and conditions of the conditional use and, in the event of non-compliance, said permit shall be subject to revocation by appropriate legal proceedings.

Section 6. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any other provision of this Ordinance.

Section 7. All ordinances, resolutions, motions or orders in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 8. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect following its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
