WHEREAS, a Class B license authorizes the sale at retail on the premises specified of alcoholic liquor for consumption on the premises only (the "Class B Liquor License"); and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Franklin Park (the "Corporate Authorities") regulate the number of liquor licenses that are available for the sale and distribution of alcoholic beverages with the Village; and

3-2-7: NUMBER OF LICENSES ISSUED:

(a) Maximum number of licenses. The maximum number of licenses which may be issued for each class shall be as follows:

The total number of class B liquor licenses shall not exceed nine (9) eight (8).

- (b) Reduction in the Number of Licenses: Whenever a license previously issued under this chapter is revoked, surrendered, non-renewed or terminated by dormancy as herein provided in this chapter, the maximum number of licenses in the class of the license which is revoked, surrendered, non-renewed or terminated by dormancy as set forth in subsection A of this section shall be automatically and immediately reduced by one.
- (c) Appropriate Number of Licenses: The Village Clerk shall codify the appropriate maximum number of licenses for each class whenever the number of license(s) is reduced by this section.
- **Section 3**. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any other provision of this Ordinance.
- **Section 4.** All ordinances, resolutions, motions or orders in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Franklin Park, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

- **Section 1.** The above recitals and legislative findings are found to be true and correct and are hereby incorporated herein and made a part hereof, as if fully set forth in their entirety.
- Section 2. The President and the Board of Trustees hereby adopt by reference the findings of fact of the Zoning Board of Appeals as findings of the President and the Board of Trustees as if completely set forth herein. All documents and exhibits submitted at the aforesaid public hearings are also incorporated by reference into this Ordinance.
- **Section 3.** In addition to the findings set forth in Section 2 hereof, the President and the Board of Trustees further finds in relation to the Proposed Conditional Use as follows:
 - 1. The establishment, maintenance or operation of the Proposed Conditional Use, subject to the conditions set forth herein, will not be detrimental to, or endanger the public health, safety, morals, comfort, or general welfare;
 - 2. The Proposed Conditional Use, subject to the conditions set forth herein, will not be injurious to the use and enjoyment of other property in the immediate vicinity for the purposes already permitted, nor substantially diminish and impair property values within the neighborhood;
 - 3. The Proposed Conditional Use, subject to the conditions set forth herein, will not impede the normal and orderly development of the surrounding property for uses permitted in the I-1 Restricted Industrial District;

- 4. The Proposed Conditional Use, subject to the conditions set forth herein, will not affect the exterior architectural appeal and functional plan of structures already constructed as to cause a substantial depreciation in property values within the neighborhood as the proposed plans will be an improvement upon the existing structure;
- 5. Adequate utilities, access roads, drainage and necessary facilities for the Proposed Conditional Use are already in place at the Property;
- 6. Ingress and egress for the Proposed Conditional Use, subject to the conditions set forth herein, shall minimally affect traffic congestion in the public streets; and
- 7. The Proposed Conditional Use shall, in all other respects, conform to the applicable regulations of the I-1 Restricted Industrial District.

Section 4. A Conditional Use, subject to the conditions set forth below, is hereby granted and issued for the operation of a "Woodworking and wood products" use in the I-1 Restricted Industrial District located at 3550 Lombard Street, Franklin Park, Illinois, and as legally described on Exhibit A

This conditional use permit is subject to the following conditions:

- 1. That all work and storage of material related to the Conditional Use shall occur indoors within the building located on the Property;

ORDINANCE NUMBER 1516-Z-

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF FRANKLIN PARK, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS, GRANTING A VARIANCE TO REDUCE THE INTERIOR SIDE YARD SET BACK (ZBA 16-03: 3853 CARNATION STREET)

WHEREAS, the Village of Franklin Park, Cook County, Illinois (the "Village") is a duly organized and existing municipal corporation created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois and under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code, as from time to time supplemented and amended; and

WHEREAS, the President and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Franklin Park (the "Corporate Authorities") have heretofore exercised the power conferred on them pursuant to Chapter 11-13-1, et seq., of the Illinois Municipal Code by adopting the Franklin Park Zoning Ordinance in 1974 (Ord. 7475 Z10), as amended from time to time; and

WHEREAS, Nancy D'Alessio, as tenant, and FN LLC, as owner of record, (the "Applicants") submitted an application, ZBA 16-03, seeking to reduce the interior yard set back from ten (10) feet to zero (0) feet (the "Proposed Variance") for the property commonly known as 3853 Carnation Street, Franklin Park, Illinois and as legally described on Exhibit A (the "Property"); and

WHEREAS, the Zoning Board of Appeals held a public hearing on February 3, 2016 on whether the Proposed Variance should be approved, at which time all persons present were afforded an opportunity to be heard; and

WHEREAS, a public notice in the form required by law was given of said public hearing dates; and

WHEREAS, the Zoning Board of Appeals has filed its findings of fact and

recommendations that the Proposed Variance be granted, and the Corporate Authorities have duly considered said findings of fact and recommendations; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities have determined, in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village, to grant the Proposed Variance subject to the conditions identified herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Village President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Franklin Park, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

- **Section 1.** That the above recitals and legislative findings are found to be true and correct and are hereby incorporated herein and made a part hereof, as if fully set forth in their entirety.
- Section 2. The Corporate Authorities adopt by reference the Report on Findings of Fact of the Zoning Board of Appeals as findings of the Corporate Authorities as if completely set forth herein. All exhibits and documents submitted at the aforesaid public hearing are also incorporated by reference as fully as if attached hereto.
- **Section 3.** In addition to the findings set forth in Section 2 hereof, the President and the Board of Trustees further find in relation to the proposed variances as follows:
 - 1. A particular hardship results from strict compliance with the requirements of the Franklin Park Zoning Ordinance due to the shape of the Property;
 - 2. The conditions upon which the application is based are unique to the Property;
 - 3. The purpose of the Proposed Variance is not based exclusively upon a desire to increase financial gain;
 - 4. The hardship has not been created by any persons having an interest in the Property;
 - 5. The grant of the Proposed Variance will not be detrimental to other property in the neighborhood in which the Property is located; and

- 6. The grant of the Proposed Variance will not adversely affect surrounding property values.
- **Section 4.** That the Proposed Variance, set forth herein, is granted for the Property, which is commonly known as 3853 Carnation Street, Franklin Park, Illinois, and is legally described on Exhibit A attached hereto. The Property is currently zoned I-1 (Restricted Industrial District), which zoning classification shall remain in effect subject to the following variation which is granted hereby:
 - 1. A variance to reduce the interior side yard setback from ten (10) feet to zero (0) feet.
- Section 5. The variation contemplated herein is granted subject to the following conditions:
 - 1. The Property is to be developed and constructed in substantial conformance with the plans as presented at the public hearing and made a part of the record;
 - 2. The property is, in all other respects, constructed in accordance with the Franklin Park Village Code; and
 - 3. The variations granted herein shall be null and void and of no force and effect whatsoever unless an application for a building permit pursuant to such variations are issued and construction commenced within six (6) months of the effective date of this Ordinance.
- **Section 6.** The Applicants hereunder shall at all times comply with the terms and conditions of the variance.
- **Section 7.** If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any of the other provisions of this Ordinance.
- **Section 8.** All ordinances, resolutions, motions or orders in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
 - Section 9. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval and

publication as provided by law.
