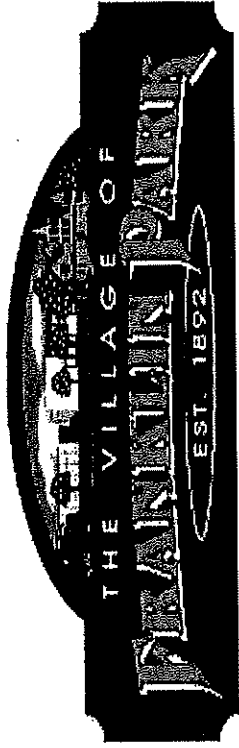

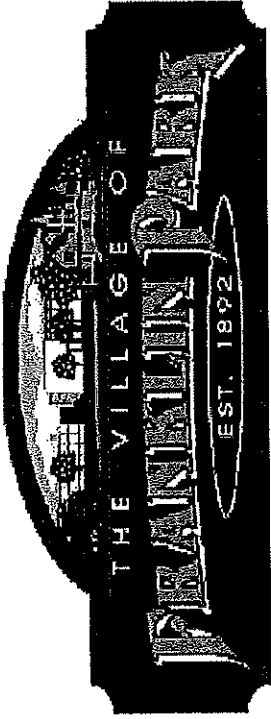

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE VILLAGE CODE OF THE VILLAGE OF FRANKLIN PARK, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS AUTHORIZING ISSUANCE OF ZONING VERIFICATION LETTERS AND THE IMPLEMENTATION OF A FEE BY THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT**

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**WHEREAS**, the Village of Franklin Park, Cook County, Illinois (the “*Village*”) is a duly organized and existing municipal corporation created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois and under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code, as from time to time supplemented and amended; and

**WHEREAS**, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Franklin Park (the “*Corporate Authorities*”) may from time to time amend the text of the Village Code of Franklin Park when it is determined to be in the best interests of the residents of the Village; and

**WHEREAS**, the Corporate Authorities find it necessary to specify a procedure for applying for a zoning verification letter and to implement a fee for obtaining said letter in order to accurately reflect the overall cost to the Village of producing the letter.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Franklin Park, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

**Section 1.** That the above recitals and legislative findings are found to be true and correct and are hereby incorporated herein and made a part hereof, as if fully set forth in their entirety.

**Section 2.** Chapter 10 (“*Administration and Enforcement*”) of Title 9 (“*Zoning Regulations*”) of the Village Code of Franklin Park, Illinois, is hereby amended by adding the following new section to read as follows:

**9-10-6-1. – Zoning verification letter.**

- (a) *Definition.* Zoning verification letter shall mean a letter executed by the Director of Community Development that shows the current zoning of a specified property.
- (b) *Request for zoning verification letter.* In the event that an individual or entity, or their respective agent, desires to obtain a zoning verification letter, said individual, entity, or agent shall submit a request to the Department of Community Development. Said request shall be made upon a form to be provided by the Department of Community Development.
- (c) *Fee.* Any individual, entity, or agent that submits a request for a zoning verification letter shall be charged a fee in accordance with a schedule of fees established by the village and must pay said fee in full before the village will issue said letter.

**Section 3.** Section 11-1-5 (“*Schedule D - Miscellaneous Fees for Village Services*”) of Chapter 1 (“*Fees, Rates and Charges*”) of Title 11 (“*Fees*”) of the Village Code of Franklin Park, Illinois, is hereby amended by adding the underlined language to read, as follows:

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Franklin Park, Cook County, Illinois (the “*Village*”) is a duly organized and existing municipal corporation created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois and under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code, as from time to time supplemented and amended; and

**WHEREAS**, the President and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Franklin Park (the “*Corporate Authorities*”) have heretofore exercised the power conferred on them pursuant to Chapter 11-13-1, *et seq.*, of the Illinois Municipal Code by adopting the Franklin Park Zoning Ordinance in 1974 (Ord. 7475 Z10), as amended from time to time; and

**WHEREAS**, a zoning map amendment application, ZBA 18-01, has been submitted by the Ridge Franklin Park Partners I, LLC, as contract purchaser (the “*Applicant*”) requesting the zoning of the property generally located at 3250 N. Elm Street, Franklin Park, Illinois, and as legally described on Exhibit A, a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof (the “*Property*”) to I-1 Restricted Industrial District (the “*Proposed Map Amendment*”); and

**WHEREAS**, the Zoning Board of Appeals held a public hearing on February 7, 2018 on whether the Proposed Map Amendment should be approved, at which time all persons present were afforded an opportunity to be heard; and

**WHEREAS**, a public notice in the form required by law was given of said public hearing date; and

**WHEREAS**, the Zoning Board of Appeals has filed its findings of fact and recommendations that the Proposed Map Amendment be granted, and the Corporate Authorities have duly considered said findings of fact and recommendations; and

**WHEREAS**, the Corporate Authorities have determined, in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village, to amend the Village of Franklin Park Zoning Map, as requested.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Franklin Park, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

**Section 1.** The above recitals and legislative findings are found to be true and correct and are hereby incorporated herein and made a part hereof, as if fully set forth in their entirety.

**Section 2.** The President and the Board of Trustees hereby adopt by reference the findings of fact of the Zoning Board of Appeals as findings of the President and the Board of Trustees as if completely set forth herein. All documents and exhibits submitted at the aforesaid public hearings are also incorporated by reference into this Ordinance.

**Section 3.** The Corporate Authorities find and determine that the adoption of the Proposed Map Amendment are in the public interest, and is in furtherance of the progressive demands of orderly Village development.

**Section 4.** Pursuant to the findings set forth in Section 2 and 3 hereof, the Corporate Authorities hereby amend the Village of Franklin Park Zoning Map, which is attached to and forms a part of the Franklin Park Zoning Ordinance in 1974 (Ord. 7475 Z10), as amended, by rezoning the Property, as legally described in Exhibit A, to I-1 Restricted Industrial District.

**Section 5.** All sections of the Franklin Park Zoning Ordinance not addressed in this Ordinance or another amending ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

**Section 6.** If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any other provision of this Ordinance.

**Section 7.** All ordinances, resolutions, motions or orders in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

**Section 8.** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval and publication as required by law.

WHEREAS, the Village's employee handbook is a manual that contains numerous personnel policies and procedures; and

WHEREAS, the Village President and Board of Trustees of the Village (the "*Corporate Authorities*") find it necessary to modify the employee handbook because of new or amended state or federal legislation, and updated or revised policies or procedures; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities further find that the employee handbook is not intended to create nor should it be construed to constitute any type of employment contract, promise or guarantee between the Village and any employee; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities have determined that it is reasonable and necessary to update and revise the employee handbook to ensure harmonious employment relationships and the efficient operation of Village services and programs.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Franklin Park, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

**Section 1.** The above recitals and legislative findings are found to be true and correct and are hereby incorporated herein and made a part hereof, as if fully set forth in their entirety.

**Section 2.** The Village of Franklin Park Employee Handbook (the “*Employee Handbook*”), a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof as Exhibit A, is hereby authorized and approved.

**Section 3.** The Director of Human Resources and Operations is hereby authorized and directed to deliver a copy of the Employee Handbook to all employees along with any other document or notice.

**Section 4.** The officials and officers of the Village are hereby authorized to undertake actions on the part of the Village as contained in the Employee Handbook to complete satisfaction of the provisions, terms or conditions stated therein.

**Section 5.** Any prior personnel policy, practice, term, provision, condition or procedure, or portion thereof, in conflict with this Employee Handbook is hereby superseded.

**Section 6.** If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any of the other provisions of this Ordinance.

**Section 7.** All ordinances, resolutions or motions, or parts thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are to the extent of such conflict hereby repealed.

**Section 8.** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval and publication as required by law.

OF THE VILLAGE OF FRANKLIN PARK, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS**

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**WHEREAS**, the Village of Franklin Park, Cook County, Illinois (the "*Village*") is a duly organized and existing municipal corporation created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois and under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code, as from time to time supplemented and amended; and

**WHEREAS**, preparations for major emergencies and disasters require contingency planning by all Village departments and agencies of local government; and

**WHEREAS**, the objective of preparing an emergency response plan is to create the capacity for the Village to save the maximum number of lives in the event of a major emergency or disaster, minimize injuries, protect property, preserve and provide governmental functions, and maintain and support economic activities essential for the survival and recovery from an emergency or disaster; and

**WHEREAS**, the Illinois Emergency Management Act, 20 ILCS 3305/11, provides that the effect of the declaration of a local emergency or disaster is to activate an emergency operations plan, which is to include activities that will occur within the Village following the activation of an emergency operations plan; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village President and Board of Trustees of the Village (the "*Corporate Authorities*") find it necessary to enact a plan to address emergency situations in which the coordination of several Village departments is necessary to ensure that emergency operations are

effective and county, state and federal levels of assistance are coordinated and mobilized to minimize the loss of life and property within the Village; and

**WHEREAS**, the Corporate Authorities have determined that it is reasonable and necessary and in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village to enact the Village of Franklin Park Emergency Operations Plan, a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof, as Exhibit A.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Franklin Park, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

**Section 1.** The above recitals and legislative findings are found to be true and correct and are hereby incorporated herein and made a part hereof, as if fully set forth in their entirety.

**Section 2.** The Village of Franklin Park Emergency Operations Plan (the "*Emergency Plan*"), a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof, as Exhibit A, is hereby authorized and approved.

**Section 3.** The Fire Chief, or such designee, is hereby authorized and directed to deliver a copy of the Emergency Plan to all necessary parties along with any other documents to effectuate the Emergency Plan.

**Section 4.** The officials and officers of the Village are hereby authorized to undertake actions on the part of the Village as contained in the Emergency Plan to complete satisfaction of the provisions, terms or conditions stated therein.

**Section 5.** If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any of the other provisions of this Ordinance.

**Section 6.** All ordinances, resolutions or motions, or parts thereof, in conflict with the

provisions of this Ordinance are to the extent of such conflict hereby repealed.

**Section 7.** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval and publication as required by law.

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**WHEREAS**, the Village of Franklin Park, Cook County, Illinois (the "*Village*") is a duly organized and existing municipal corporation created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois and under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code, as from time to time supplemented and amended; and

**WHEREAS**, Article VII, Section 10 of the Illinois Constitution of 1970 authorizes units of local government to enter into contract to exercise, combine or transfer any power or function not prohibited by law; and

**WHEREAS**, the Intergovernmental Cooperation Act, 5 ILCS 220/1 *et seq.*, (the "*Act*") authorizes units of local government to exercise jointly with any public agency of the State, including other units of local government, any power, privilege or authority which may be exercised by a unit of local government individually, and to enter into contracts for the performance of governmental services, activities or undertakings; and

**WHEREAS**, it is the desire of the Village President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Franklin Park (the "*Corporate Authorities*") to enter into the Passenger Shelter Agreement by and among Pace, the Suburban Bus Division of the Regional Transportation Authority, the Village of Franklin Park and Intersection Media, LLC (the "*Agreement*"), a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof as Exhibit A.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Village President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Franklin Park, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

**Section 1.** That the above recitals and legislative findings are found to be true and correct and are hereby incorporated herein and made a part hereof, as if fully set forth in their entirety.

**Section 5.** If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any of the other provisions of this Ordinance.

**Section 6.** All ordinances, resolutions or motions, or parts thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are to the extent of such conflict hereby repealed.
