

WHEREAS, the Village of Franklin Park, Cook County, Illinois (the "Village") is a duly organized and existing municipal corporation created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois and under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code, as from time to time supplemented and amended; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Commissioners of the County of Cook have enacted an ordinance known as the Cook County Real Property Assessment Classification Ordinance, as amended from time to time (the "Classification Ordinance"), which provides for a tax assessment incentive classification designed to encourage industrial development throughout Cook County by offering a real estate tax incentive for the development of new industrial facilities, the rehabilitation of existing industrial structures and the utilization of abandoned industrial buildings in order to create employment opportunities and expand the tax base; and

WHEREAS, Ridge Franklin Park Partners I, LLC (the "Applicant") is the owner of a certain parcel of industrial property commonly known as 9100 Belmont Avenue, Franklin Park, Illinois, and hereinafter legally described on Exhibit A, a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof (the "Property"); and

WHEREAS, Applicant intends to construct a Class A industrial speculative facility with not less than 175,000 square footage under roof on the Property, the viability of such being dependent on the granting of a Class 6B Tax Assessment Classification, as said term is defined in the Classification Ordinance (the "Class 6B Tax Assessment Classification"); and

WHEREAS, Applicant has requested that the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Franklin Park (the "Corporate Authorities") support and consent to the filing of its application for a Cook County Class 6B Real Estate Tax Assessment Classification for the Property; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Franklin Park (the "Corporate Authorities") may from time to time amend the text of the Village Code of Franklin Park when it is determined to be in the best interests of the residents of the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities find it necessary to specify a procedure for applying for a zoning verification letter and to implement a fee for obtaining said letter in order to accurately reflect the overall cost to the Village of producing the letter.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Franklin Park, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

- Section 1. That the above recitals and legislative findings are found to be true and correct and are hereby incorporated herein and made a part hereof, as if fully set forth in their entirety.
- Section 2. Chapter 10 ("Administration and Enforcement") of Title 9 ("Zoning Regulations") of the Village Code of Franklin Park, Illinois, is hereby amended by adding the following new section to read as follows:

9-10-6-1. – Zoning verification letter.

- (a) Definition. Zoning verification letter shall mean a letter executed by the Director of Community Development that shows the current zoning of a specified property.
- (b) Request for zoning verification letter. In the event that an individual or entity, or their respective agent, desires to obtain a zoning verification letter, said individual, entity, or agent shall submit a request to the Department of Community Development. Said request shall be made upon a form to be provided by the Department of Community Development.
- (c) Fee. Any individual, entity, or agent that submits a request for a zoning verification letter shall be charged a fee in accordance with a schedule of fees established by the village and must pay said fee in full before the village will issue said letter.

Section 3. Section 11-1-5 ("Schedule D - Miscellaneous Fees for Village Services") of Chapter 1 ("Fees, Rates and Charges") of Title 11 ("Fees") of the Village Code of Franklin Park, Illinois, is hereby amended by adding the underlined language to read, as follows:

- Section 3. The Corporate Authorities find and determine that the adoption of the Proposed Map Amendment are in the public interest, and is in furtherance of the progressive demands of orderly Village development.
- **Section 4.** Pursuant to the findings set forth in Section 2 and 3 hereof, the Corporate Authorities hereby amend the Village of Franklin Park Zoning Map, which is attached to and forms a part of the Franklin Park Zoning Ordinance in 1974 (Ord. 7475 Z10), as amended, by rezoning the Property, as legally described in Exhibit A, to I-1 Restricted Industrial District.
- Section 5. All sections of the Franklin Park Zoning Ordinance not addressed in this Ordinance or another amending ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

- **Section 6**. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any other provision of this Ordinance.
- Section 7. All ordinances, resolutions, motions or orders in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
- Section 8. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval and publication as required by law.

WHEREAS, the Illinois Emergency Management Act, 20 ILCS 3305/11, provides that the effect of the declaration of a local emergency or disaster is to activate an emergency operations plan, which is to include activities that will occur within the Village following the activation of an emergency operations plan; and

WHEREAS, the Village President and Board of Trustees of the Village (the "Corporate Authorities") find it necessary to enact a plan to address emergency situations in which the coordination of several Village departments is necessary to ensure that emergency operations are

effective and county, state and federal levels of assistance are coordinated and mobilized to minimize the loss of life and property within the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities have determined that it is reasonable and necessary and in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village to enact the Village of Franklin Park Emergency Operations Plan, a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof, as Exhibit A.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Franklin Park, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

- Section 1. The above recitals and legislative findings are found to be true and correct and are hereby incorporated herein and made a part hereof, as if fully set forth in their entirety.
- Section 2. The Village of Franklin Park Emergency Operations Plan (the "Emergency Plan"), a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof, as Exhibit A, is hereby authorized and approved.
- **Section 3.** The Fire Chief, or such designee, is hereby authorized and directed to deliver a copy of the Emergency Plan to all necessary parties along with any other documents to effectuate the Emergency Plan.
- Section 4. The officials and officers of the Village are hereby authorized to undertake actions on the part of the Village as contained in the Emergency Plan to complete satisfaction of the provisions, terms or conditions stated therein.
- Section 5. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any of the other provisions of this Ordinance.

provisions of this Ordinance are to the extent of such conflict hereby repealed.
