(AMENDING SALARY SCHEDULE ORDINANCE)

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WHEREAS, the Village of Franklin Park, Cook County, Illinois (the "*Village*") is a duly organized and existing municipal corporation created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois and under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code, as from time to time supplemented and amended; and

WHEREAS, on September 4, 2018, the Village President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Franklin Park (the "*Corporate Authorities*") approved Ordinance Number 1819-G-18 entitled "*An Ordinance of the Village of Franklin Park, Cook County, Illinois Establishing Salary Schedules and Other Compensation*" (the "*Salary Schedule Ordinance*"), as from time to time supplemented and amended; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities find it necessary to amend the Salary Schedule Ordinance in order to accurately reflect salary schedule adjustments and the reassignment of duties amongst personnel.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Franklin Park, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

**Section 1.** That the above recitals and legislative findings are found to be true and correct and are hereby incorporated herein and made a part hereof, as if fully set forth in their entirety.

**Section 2.** The salary of the "*Director, Building Department/ Sustainable Practices Manager\* - Part Time*" at a rate of \$51,125.00, as set forth in Section 2 of the Salary Schedule Ordinance subsection entitled "*Administrative (40 hours per week - unless otherwise indicated)*" is

hereby amended to read, as follows:

*“Director, Building Department/ Sustainable Practices Manager\* - Part Time \$69,037.00”*

**Section 3.** The automatic percentile increase for the period May 1, 2019 through and including April 30, 2020, as set forth in Section 5 of the Salary Schedule Ordinance, shall not be applicable to the positions of *Director, Building Department/ Sustainable Practices Manager\* - Part Time* and *Division Supervisor: Water*.

**Section 4.** Section 2 of the Salary Schedule Ordinance subsection entitled *“Administrative (40 hours per week – unless otherwise indicated)”* is hereby amended by deleting the following stricken language and adding the underlined language to read, as follows:

*Planners\** ~~\_\_\_\_\_~~ ~~\$49,080.00~~

*Senior Planner\** \$60,000.00

*Planner\** \$48,000.00

**Section 5.** The amendments set forth in Section 2, Section 3, and Section 4 of this Ordinance, amending the Salary Schedule Ordinance, shall be in full force and effect retroactive to February 17, 2019.

**Section 6.** The remaining provisions and terms as contained in the Salary Schedule Ordinance are not altered, amended or otherwise modified by this Ordinance and remain in full force and effect.

**Section 7.** If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any other provision of this Ordinance.

**Section 8.** All ordinances, resolutions, motions or orders in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

**Section 9.** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.

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**WHEREAS**, the Village of Franklin Park, Cook County, Illinois (the "*Village*") is a duly organized and existing municipal corporation created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois and under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code, as from time to time supplemented and amended; and

**WHEREAS**, the President and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Franklin Park (the "*Corporate Authorities*") have heretofore exercised the power conferred on them pursuant to Chapter 11-13-1, *et seq.*, of the Illinois Municipal Code by adopting the Franklin Park Zoning Ordinance in 1974 (Ord. 7475 Z10), as amended from time to time; and

**WHEREAS**, a conditional use application, ZBA 19-03, has been submitted to the Village by of Car EFI, Inc., as tenant, and Louis A. Minaglia, as owner, (collectively, the "*Applicants*") to allow within the CM Commercial Manufacturing District an "automobile repair" use (the "*Proposed Conditional Use*") on the property commonly known as 10130 Franklin Avenue, Franklin Park, Illinois and as legally described and depicted on Exhibit A (the "*Property*"); and

**WHEREAS**, the Zoning Board of Appeals held a public hearing on February 6, 2019, on whether the Proposed Conditional Use should be approved, at which time all persons present were afforded an opportunity to be heard; and

**WHEREAS**, the Corporate Authorities have determined, in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village, to grant the Proposed Conditional Use subject to the conditions identified herein.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Franklin Park, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

**Section 1.** The above recitals and legislative findings are found to be true and correct and are hereby incorporated herein and made a part hereof, as if fully set forth in their entirety.

**Section 2.** The President and the Board of Trustees hereby adopt by reference the findings of fact of the Zoning Board of Appeals as findings of the President and the Board of Trustees as if completely set forth herein. All documents and exhibits submitted at the aforesaid public hearings are also incorporated by reference into this Ordinance.

**Section 3.** In addition to the findings set forth in Section 2 hereof, the President and the Board of Trustees further finds in relation to the Proposed Conditional Use as follows:

1. The establishment, maintenance or operation of the Proposed Conditional Use, subject to the conditions set forth herein, will not be detrimental to, or endanger the public health, safety, morals, comfort, or general welfare;
2. The Proposed Conditional Use, subject to the conditions set forth herein, will not be injurious to the use and enjoyment of other property in the immediate vicinity for the purposes already permitted, nor substantially diminish and impair property values within the neighborhood;
3. The Proposed Conditional Use, subject to the conditions set forth herein, will not impede the normal and orderly development of the surrounding property for uses permitted in the CM Commercial Manufacturing District;

4. The Proposed Conditional Use, subject to the conditions set forth herein, will not affect the exterior architectural appeal and functional plan of structures already constructed as to cause a substantial depreciation in property values within the neighborhood as the proposed plans will be an improvement upon the existing structure;
5. Adequate utilities, access roads, drainage and necessary facilities for the Proposed Conditional Use are already in place at the Property;
6. Ingress and egress for the Proposed Conditional Use, subject to the conditions set forth herein, shall minimally affect traffic congestion in the public streets; and
7. The Proposed Conditional Use shall, in all other respects, conform to the applicable regulations of the CM Commercial Manufacturing District, except as such regulations may, in each instance, be modified by the Board of Trustees pursuant to the recommendations of the Zoning Board of Appeals.

**Section 4.** A Conditional Use, subject to the conditions set forth below, is hereby granted and issued for the allowance of automobile repair in the CM Commercial Manufacturing District located at 10130 Franklin Avenue, Franklin Park, Illinois, and as legally described and depicted on Exhibit A.

This conditional use is subject to the following conditions:

1. That no outdoor storage of motor vehicles in disrepair shall take place on the site or off the site and all such vehicles shall be stored inside;
2. That all operations related to this use shall only be conducted within the primary structure on the Property;
3. That no sales of vehicles take place on the Property
4. That an opaque fence between six and eight feet in height be installed along the length of the zoning lot (north end of lot); and
5. That there be a dumpster enclosure installed per Village Code;
6. That the Conditional Use at all times comply with all Village codes and regulations;
7. That this Conditional Use shall be limited to Applicants, and shall not be

transferable except upon reapplication, hearing and approval in the manner provided in the Franklin Park Zoning Ordinance;

8. This Ordinance shall be signed by the Applicants to signify acknowledgement of the terms hereof;

**Section 5.** The Applicants hereunder shall at all times comply with all Village regulations and the terms and conditions of the conditional use and in the event of non-compliance, said permit shall be subject to revocation by appropriate legal proceedings.

**Section 6.** If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any other provision of this Ordinance.

**Section 7.** All ordinances, resolutions, motions or orders in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

**Section 8.** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect following its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.

6. This Ordinance shall be signed by the Applicants to signify acknowledgement of the terms hereof;

**Section 5.** The Applicants hereunder shall at all times comply with all Village regulations and the terms and conditions of the conditional use and in the event of non-compliance, said permit shall be subject to revocation by appropriate legal proceedings.

**Section 6.** If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any other provision of this Ordinance.

**Section 7.** All ordinances, resolutions, motions or orders in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

**Section 8.** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect following its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
