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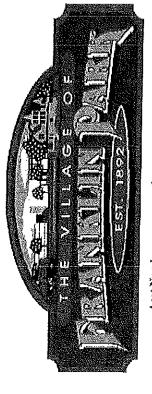

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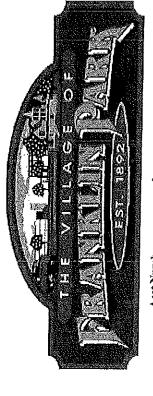

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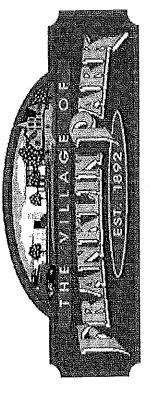

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF FRANKLIN PARK, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS AMENDING FEES AND RATES FOR INSPECTION SERVICES AND ACTIVITES REGULATED BY THE BUILDING DEPARTMENT IN SECTION 7-10B-3 AND SECTION 11-1-1 OF THE VILLAGE CODE OF THE VILLAGE OF FRANKLIN PARK, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, the Village of Franklin Park, Cook County, Illinois (the "Village") is a duly organized and existing municipal corporation created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois and under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code, as from time to time supplemented and amended; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Franklin Park (the "Corporate Authorities") may from time to time amend the text of the Village Code of Franklin Park when it is determined to be in the best interests of the residents of the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities find it necessary to amend the fees, rates and charges for various services and activities in order to more accurately reflect the overall cost of such services and enforcement procedures.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Franklin Park, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

- **Section 1**. That the above recitals and legislative findings are found to be true and correct and are hereby incorporated herein and made a part hereof, as if fully set forth in their entirety.
- Section 2. Section 7-10B-3 ("Fee for Inspection and Review") of Article B ("Review of Documents Relative to Transfer of Ownership") of Chapter 10 ("Transfer of Real Property") of Title 7 ("Public Works and Properties") of the Village Code of Franklin Park, Illinois, is hereby amended by deleting the following stricken language and adding the underlined language to read, as follows:

7-10B-3. Fee for inspection and review.

The fee for inspection and review of the deed or document of transfer of ownership shall be seventy-five dollars (\$75.00) one hundred dollars (\$100.00). An additional inspection fee for residential units shall be twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) for the first unit and twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) for each additional unit. In C-1, C-2 and C-3 districts, commercial districts, and downtown zoning districts, the fee shall be as set forth in the chart below; in C-M, I-1, and I-2 districts, and industrial zoning districts, the fee shall be as set forth in the chart below:

WHEREAS, it is desirable and in the best interests of the citizens of the Village, for the Village to adopt tax increment allocation financing pursuant to the Illinois Tax Increment Allocation Redevelopment Act, as amended, 65 ILCS 5/11-74.4-1, et seq. (the "TIF Act"); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the TIF Act, the Village President and Board of Trustees of the Village (collectively, the "Corporate Authorities") have heretofore approved the Seymour Avenue / Waveland Avenue Redevelopment Plan and Project, including the TIF Qualification Report, (the "Plan") as required by the TIF Act by passage of an ordinance and have heretofore designated the Seymour Avenue / Waveland Avenue Redevelopment Project Area (the "Area") as required by the TIF Act by passage of an ordinance and have otherwise complied with all other conditions precedent required by the TIF Act.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Franklin Park, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. Tax Increment Financing Adoption. Tax increment allocation financing is hereby adopted to pay redevelopment project costs, as defined in the TIF Act and as set forth in the Plan, within the Area, as legally described in Exhibit A, attached hereto and

incorporated herein. The map of the Area showing the street location is depicted in *Exhibit B*, attached hereto and incorporated herein as if set out in full by this reference.

Section 2. Allocation of Ad Valorem Taxes. Pursuant to the TIF Act, the ad valorem taxes, if any, arising from the levies upon taxable real property in the Area by taxing districts and tax rates determined in the manner provided in Section 11-74.4-9(c) of the TIF Act each year after the effective date of this Ordinance until the project costs and obligations issued in respect thereto have been paid, shall be divided as follows:

- (a) That portion of taxes levied upon each taxable lot, block, tract, or parcel of real property which is attributable to the lower of the current equalized assessed value or the initial equalized assessed value of each such taxable lot, block, tract, or parcel of real property in the Area, shall be allocated to and when collected shall be paid by the county collector to the respective affected taxing districts, in the manner required by law in the absence of the adoption of tax increment allocation financing.
- (b) That portion, if any, of such taxes which is attributable to the increase in the current equalized assessed valuation of each lot, block, tract, or parcel of real property in the Area over and above the initial equalized assessed value of each property in the Area, shall be allocated to and when collected shall be paid to the municipal treasurer or to his designee, pursuant to Section 207A of the Revenue Act of 1939 of the State of Illinois, as amended, who shall deposit said taxes into a special fund, hereby created, and designated the "Village of Franklin Park Seymour Avenue / Waveland Avenue Tax Increment Redevelopment Project Area

Special Tax Allocation Fund" of the Village, and such taxes shall be used for the purpose of paying project costs and obligations incurred in the payment thereof.

Section 3. *Invalidity of Any Section*. If any section, paragraph, or provision of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the invalidity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph, or provision shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this Ordinance.

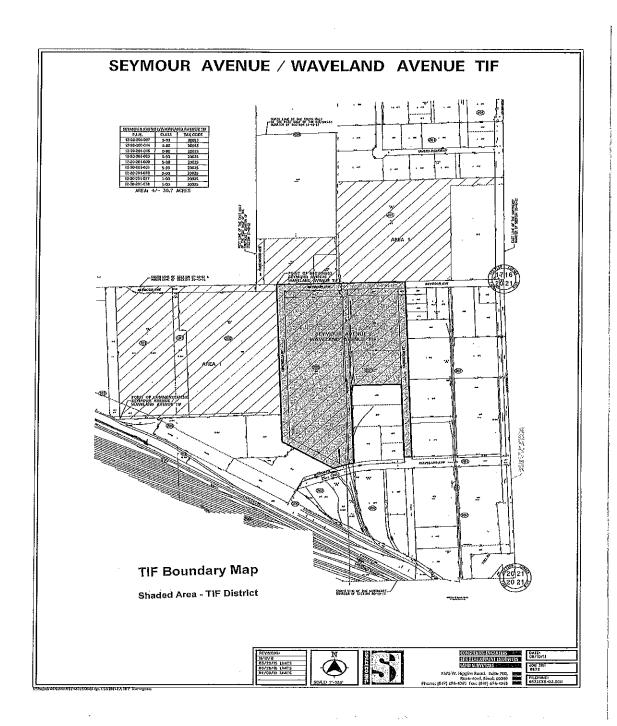

Project Area Boundary

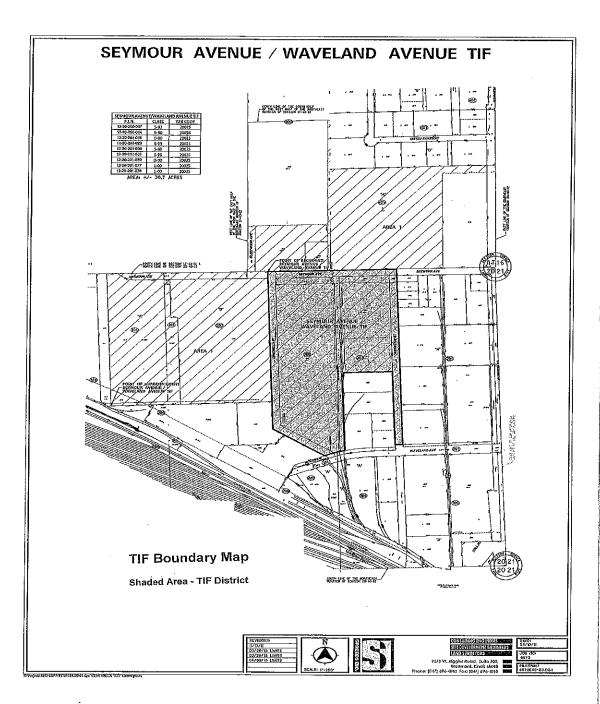

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF FRANKLIN PARK, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS, ADOPTING THE SEYMOUR AVENUE / WAVELAND AVENUE TAX INCREMENT FINANCING REDEVELOPMENT PLAN AND PROJECT

WHEREAS, the Village of Franklin Park, Cook County, Illinois (the "Village") is a duly organized and existing municipal corporation created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois and under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code, as from time to time supplemented and amended; and

WHEREAS, the Village President and Board of Trustees of the Village (collectively, the "Corporate Authorities"), have determined that the stable economic and physical development of the Village is endangered by the presence of blighting factors as often manifested by progressive and advanced deterioration of structures, by a lack of physical maintenance of such structures, by obsolete structures and inadequate utilities, by obsolete platting, by deleterious land use and layout, and by a decline or marginal growth in equalized assessed value, which impair the value of private investments, threaten the sound growth and the tax base of the Village as well as the taxing districts having the power to tax real property in the Village (the "Taxing Districts"), and further threaten the health, safety, and welfare of the public; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities have determined that in order to promote and protect the health, safety, and welfare of the public, the aforesaid blighted conditions in the Village need to be eradicated and redevelopment of the Village be undertaken in order to remove and alleviate adverse conditions, encourage private investment, and restore and enhance the tax base of the Taxing Districts; and

WHEREAS, an eligibility study has been commissioned to determine whether the

proposed Seymour Avenue / Waveland Avenue Redevelopment Project Area (the "*Project Area*") qualifies as a "redevelopment project area" pursuant to the Illinois Tax Increment Allocation Redevelopment Act (the "*TIF Act*") 65 ILCS 5/11-74.4-1, *et seq.*; and

WHEREAS, the Village has heretofore evaluated various lawfully available programs to provide such assistance and has determined that the use of tax increment allocation financing is necessary to achieve the redevelopment goals of the Village for the Project Area; and

WHEREAS, the Village has been advised by Kane, McKenna and Associates, Inc., in April of 2015 that the Project Area qualifies as a "redevelopment project area" under Section 11-74.4-3 of the TIF Act; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities have concluded that the Project Area remains qualified as a "redevelopment project area" under Section 11-74.4-3 of the TIF Act as of the date hereof; and

WHEREAS, the Village has further caused the preparation of and made available for public inspection the Seymour Avenue / Waveland Avenue Redevelopment Plan and Project, including the TIF Qualification Report, which includes a proposed redevelopment plan for the Project Area (the "Plan and Project"); and

WHEREAS, the Plan and Project sets forth in writing the program to be undertaken to accomplish the objectives of the Village and includes estimated redevelopment project costs proposed for the Project Area, evidence indicating that the Project Area on the whole has not been subject to growth and development through investment by private enterprise, an assessment of the financial impact of the Project Area on, or any increased demand for services from, any taxing district affected by the Plan and Project, any program to address such financial impact or increased demand, the sources of funds to pay costs, the nature and term of any obligations to be

issued, the most recent equalized assessed valuation of the Project Area, an estimate as to the equalized assessed valuation after redevelopment, the general land uses to apply in the Project Area, and a commitment to fair employment practices and an affirmative action plan, and the Plan and Project accordingly complies in all respects with the requirements of the TIF Act; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 11-74.4-5 of the TIF Act, the Corporate Authorities by an ordinance adopted the 20th day of April, 2015, called a public hearing (the "*Hearing*") relative to the Plan and Project and the designation of the Project Area as a redevelopment project area under the TIF Act, and fixed the time and place for such Hearing for the 15th day of June 2015, at 6:00 p.m., at the Community Room, Franklin Park Police Station, Village of Franklin Park, 9451 W. Belmont Avenue, Franklin Park, Illinois; and

WHEREAS, due notice in respect to such Hearing was given pursuant to Sections 11-74.4-5 and 11-74.4-6 of the TIF Act, said notice, together with a copy of the Plan and Project, was sent to the Taxing Districts and to the Illinois Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity of the State of Illinois by certified mail on April 22, 2015, and was published on May 28, 2015 and June 4, 2015, and sent by certified mail to taxpayers within the Project Area on May 26, 2015; and

WHEREAS, the Village has established and gave public notice of an "interested parties registry" for the Project Area in compliance with the requirements of the TIF Act; and

WHEREAS, the Village gave such notice to all persons and organizations who have registered for information with such registry, all in the manner and at the times as provided in the TIF Act; and

WHEREAS, the Village determined that there are no residents within 750 feet of the boundaries of the Project Area; and

WHEREAS, the Village convened a Joint Review Board, as required by and in all respects in compliance with the provisions of the TIF Act; and

WHEREAS, the Joint Review Board met at the time and as required by the TIF Act, and reviewed the public record, planning documents, and a form of proposed ordinance approving the Plan and Project; and

WHEREAS, the Joint Review Board adopted by a majority vote an advisory, non-binding recommendation that the Village proceed to implement the Plan and Project and to designate the Project Area as a redevelopment project area under the TIF Act; and

WHEREAS, the Joint Review Board based its decision to approve the proposal on the basis of the Project Area satisfying the eligibility criteria defined in Section 11-74.4-3 of the TIF Act, all as provided in Section 11-74.4-5(b) of the TIF Act; and

WHEREAS, the Village held the Hearing on June 15, 2015, at 6:00 p.m., at the Community Room, Franklin Park Police Station, Village of Franklin Park, 9451 W. Belmont Avenue, Franklin Park, Illinois; and

WHEREAS, at the Hearing, any interested party or affected Taxing District was permitted to file with the Village Clerk written objections and was heard orally in respect to any issues embodied in the notice of said Hearing, and the Village heard and determined all protests and objections at the Hearing; and

WHEREAS, the Hearing was adjourned on the 15th day of June, 2015; and

WHEREAS, the Plan and Project set forth the factors which cause the unimproved/vacant parcels in the Project Area to be a blighted area, and the Corporate Authorities have reviewed the information concerning such factors presented at the Hearing, and are generally informed of the conditions in the Project Area which could cause the Project Area

to be a vacant blighted area all as set forth in the TIF Act; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities have reviewed evidence indicating that the Project Area on the whole has not been subject to growth and development through investment by private enterprise, and have reviewed the conditions pertaining to lack of private investment in the Project Area to determine whether private development would take place in the Project Area as a whole without the adoption of the proposed Plan and Project; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities have reviewed the conditions pertaining to real property in the Project Area to determine whether contiguous parcels of real property and improvements thereon in the Project Area would be substantially benefited by the proposed project improvements; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities have made an assessment of any financial impact of the Project Area on or any increased demand for services from any Taxing District affected by the Plan and Project, and any program to address such financial impact or increased demand; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities have reviewed the Plan and Project and the existing comprehensive plan for development of the Village as a whole, to determine whether the Plan and Project conform to the comprehensive plan of the Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Franklin Park, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

- **Section 1.** Findings. The Corporate Authorities hereby make the following findings:
 - (a) The Project Area is legally described in *Exhibit A*, attached hereto and incorporated herein as if set out in full by this reference. The map of the Project Area showing the street location is depicted in *Exhibit B*, attached hereto and incorporated herein as if set out in full by this reference.

- (b) There exist conditions which cause the Project Area to be subject to designation as a redevelopment project area under the TIF Act and for the unimproved/vacant parcels to be classified as a vacant blighted area, all as set forth in Section 11-74.4-3 of the TIF Act.
- (c) The Project Area on the whole has not been subject to growth and development through investment by private enterprise and would not be reasonably anticipated to be developed without the adoption of the Plan and Project.
- (d) The Plan and Project conforms to the comprehensive plan for the development of the Village as a whole.
- (e) As set forth in the Plan and Project and in the testimony at the public hearing, the date of completion of the Plan and Project and the date of the retirement of any obligation incurred to finance redevelopment project costs as defined in the Plan and Project are estimated to be December 31st of the year in which the payment to the municipal treasurer, as provided in the TIF Act, is to be made with respect to ad valorem taxes levied in the 23rd calendar year after the year in which this Ordinance is adopted.
- (f) The parcels of real property in the Proposed Area are contiguous, and only those contiguous parcels of real property and improvements thereon which will be substantially benefited by the Plan and Project improvements are included in the Project Area.
- Section 2. Exhibits Incorporated by Reference. The Plan and Project which were the subject matter of the public hearing held on the 15th day of June, 2015, are hereby adopted

and approved. A copy of the Plan and Project is set forth in *Exhibit C*, attached hereto and incorporated herein.

Section 3. *Invalidity of Any Section*. If any section, paragraph, or provision of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the invalidity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph, or provision shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this Ordinance.

Section 4. Superseder. All ordinances, resolutions, motions or orders in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 5. *Effective Date*. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect following its passage and approval as provided by law.

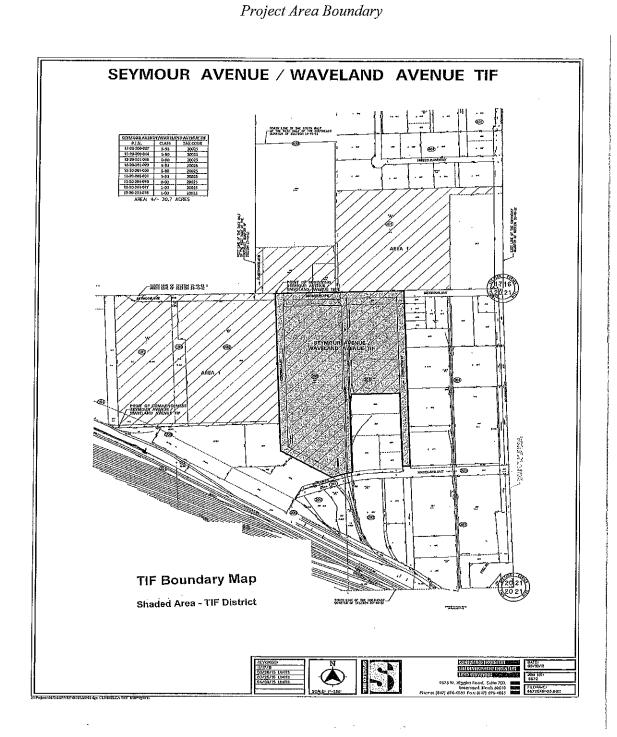

WHEREAS, the Village of Franklin Park, Cook County, Illinois (the "Village") is a duly organized and existing municipal corporation created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois and under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code, as from time to time supplemented and amended; and

WHEREAS, the President and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Franklin Park (the "Corporate Authorities") have heretofore exercised the power conferred on them pursuant to Chapter 11-13-1, et seq., of the Illinois Municipal Code by adopting the Franklin Park Zoning Ordinance in 1974 (Ord. 7475 Z10), as amended from time to time; and

WHEREAS, a conditional use application, ZBA 15-10, has been submitted to the Village by David Tamez and Avni Patel (the "Applicants") to allow within the I-2 General Industrial District the operation of an "Garage for storage, repair and servicing of motor vehicles, including body repair, painting and engine rebuilding" use (the "Proposed Conditional Use") on the property commonly known as 11127 Franklin Avenue, Franklin Park, Illinois and as legally described on Exhibit A (the "Property"); and

WHEREAS, the Zoning Board of Appeals held a public hearing on July 1, 2015 on whether the Proposed Conditional Use should be approved, at which time all persons present were afforded an opportunity to be heard; and

WHEREAS, a public notice in the form required by law was given of said public hearing

dates; and

WHEREAS, the Zoning Board of Appeals has filed its findings of fact and recommendations that the Proposed Conditional Use be granted, and the Corporate Authorities have duly considered said findings of fact and recommendations; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities have determined, in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village, to grant the Proposed Conditional Use subject to the conditions identified herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Franklin Park, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

- **Section 1.** The above recitals and legislative findings are found to be true and correct and are hereby incorporated herein and made a part hereof, as if fully set forth in their entirety.
- Section 2. The President and the Board of Trustees hereby adopt by reference the findings of fact of the Zoning Board of Appeals as findings of the President and the Board of Trustees as if completely set forth herein. All documents and exhibits submitted at the aforesaid public hearings are also incorporated by reference into this Ordinance.
- **Section 3.** In addition to the findings set forth in Section 2 hereof, the President and the Board of Trustees further finds in relation to the Proposed Conditional Use as follows:
 - 1. The establishment, maintenance or operation of the Proposed Conditional Use, subject to the conditions set forth herein, will not be detrimental to, or endanger the public health, safety, morals, comfort, or general welfare;
 - 2. The Proposed Conditional Use, subject to the conditions set forth herein, will not be injurious to the use and enjoyment of other property in the immediate vicinity for the purposes already permitted, nor substantially diminish and impair property values within the neighborhood;
 - 3. The Proposed Conditional Use, subject to the conditions set forth herein, will not impede the normal and orderly development of the surrounding property for uses

permitted in the I-2 General Industrial District;

- 4. The Proposed Conditional Use, subject to the conditions set forth herein, will not affect the exterior architectural appeal and functional plan of structures already constructed as to cause a substantial depreciation in property values within the neighborhood as the proposed plans will be an improvement upon the existing structure;
- 5. Adequate utilities, access roads, drainage and necessary facilities for the Proposed Conditional Use are already in place at the Property;
- 6. Ingress and egress for the Proposed Conditional Use, subject to the conditions set forth herein, shall minimally affect traffic congestion in the public streets; and
- 7. The Proposed Conditional Use shall, in all other respects, conform to the applicable regulations of the I-2 General Industrial District.

Section 4. A Conditional Use, subject to the conditions set forth below, is hereby granted and issued for the operation of a "Garage for storage, repair and servicing of motor vehicles, including body repair, painting and engine rebuilding" use in the I-2 General Industrial District located at 11127 Franklin Avenue, Franklin Park, Illinois, and legally described as follows:

LOT 3 IN LATORIA BROTHERS CONSTRUCTION INC. SUBDIVISION UNIT NO. 2 OF PART OF THE WEST HALF OF SECTION 20 NORTH, RANGE 12, EAST OF THE THIRD PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN, IN COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS.

This conditional use permit is subject to the following conditions:

- 1. That all work and storage related to the Conditional Use shall occur indoors within the building located on the Property;
- 2. That the Conditional Use at the Property complies with all other codes and ordinances of the Village of Franklin Park;
- 3. That this Conditional Use shall be limited to David Tamez and shall not be transferable except upon reapplication, hearing and approval in the manner provided in the Franklin Park Zoning Ordinance; and

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF FRANKLIN PARK, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS ESTABLISHING SALARY SCHEDULES AND OTHER COMPENSATION

WHEREAS, the Village of Franklin Park, Cook County, Illinois (the "Village") is a duly organized and existing municipal corporation created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois and under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code, as from time to time supplemented and amended.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Franklin Park, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. That the above recital is found to be true and correct and is hereby incorporated herein and made a part hereof, as if fully set forth in its entirety.

Section 2. That the officers and employees of the Village, as herein provided, shall be paid in accordance with the following schedule for the period of May 1, 2014 to April 30, 2015, and as subsequently calculated as herein provided, or until such further action by the Board of Trustees. Except where indicated otherwise, the amounts set forth opposite the position are stated in terms on an annual basis. For exempt employees, the amount indicated as an annual amount is the upper limit of compensation to be paid. For payroll adjustment purposes, the computation of payment based on hourly amounts for non-salaried employees where an annual amount of compensation has been provided appears after the annual statement in parentheses. Collective Bargaining Units:

Section 3(A). All non-union employees, officers and officials are eligible to participate in the Village employees' hospitalization, dental, short and long term disability insurance programs. Non-union employees shall be eligible for single and/or dependent coverage at their option. Elected officials shall only be eligible for single coverage, but the Village President shall be eligible for dependant coverage, commencing with the new term of office following the election in April 2009, provided the Village President performs as a full-time Village President. With respect to non-union employees, the Village Comptroller is hereby directed to retain from payment of wages an amount equal to twenty percent (20%) of the health and dental insurance premiums assessable to the employee under the health and dental insurance program as elected by the employee. Such retained amounts shall be co-payments by the employee for participation in the Village's health insurance plan and program. The compensation of all elected officials elected on or after April 1, 2003 shall include 100% of the premium for single coverage under the Village's group health insurance plan to be paid by the Village, for those elected officials who elect coverage; and after the election in April 2009, 80% of the premium for dependent coverage for the Village President, to be paid by the Village, if the Village President so elects said coverage.

Section 3(B). Non-union employees are hereby authorized to accumulate sick days. Upon retirement, these sick days, if sufficient, can be used to purchase up to one additional year of service under the Village's retirement plan (Illinois Municipal Retirement Fund – IMRF).

Section 3(C). That for purposes of determining the time of service to be eligible for progressing in steps where steps are provided for determining the salaries and other compensation involved in a position, the time of service is based solely upon active duty service, the progression from steps being determined as a function of experience on the job, and absence from active duty shall not be included in calculation of service salary purposes.

Section 4. Salary Schedule Relationship to New Employee; Employees at New Position, and Periodic Review/ Evaluation of Employees.

The scheduled amount of compensation set forth in this Ordinance to the extent applied to positions other than those of officers and department heads or positions for which compensation is provided by other current ordinance of the Village other than the Appropriation Ordinance and the Tax Levy Ordinance or by contract, may be reduced or increased as to a particular position under the circumstance and in the manner as provided in this Section.

- In the event that a new employee is being hired to fill a vacant or new position, the employee shall be hired in an amount not to exceed the then current amount as provided for the position in this Ordinance. The amount of entry level compensation shall be recommended by the appropriate department head or supervisor and the Village Comptroller shall report the recommendation to the Board of Trustees for approval. All such recommendations shall be confidential and shall be based on the person's experience, skills, this Ordinance, the available funds remaining in the appropriations for the department or program involved, and such other matters deemed relevant by the person submitting the recommendation. Every new employee affected by the provision of this paragraph may be hired through a probationary status pending approval of salary amount as may be necessary by the Board of Trustees. Failure by the Board of Trustees to act on the recommendation within ninety (90) days of its submittal will constitute approval of the recommendation as submitted by the Village Comptroller.
- 2) In the event that a current employee is being transferred to fill a vacant or new position, that employee shall be paid no more than the amount set opposite the position that is being filled as provided in this Ordinance. In the event that an adjustment to the amount of compensation is deemed appropriate by the department head or immediate supervisor and the Village Comptroller, then the procedures as set forth in Paragraph (1) of this section shall be followed.
- In the event that department head or supervisor of employees determines that the 3) amount of compensation, after review and evaluation of the performance of an employee, is inappropriate and should be adjusted either upward or downward, then such person may prepare a written recommendation stating the reasons, in support of the recommended adjustment and the specific circumstances which occasioned review and evaluation of the employee's performance and a projection of the expected results that may be reasonably associated with the adjustment as they relate to performance and morale within the department affected and as to the individual employee. The recommendation shall be filed with the Village Comptroller who shall review it to determine whether the funds available by appropriation to the department are sufficient given the recommended adjustment. After review for that purpose, the Village Comptroller shall file, or cause to be filed, the recommendation with the Board of Trustees. No adjustment in the amount shall occur absent confirmation by the Village Comptroller as to the sufficiency of funds appropriated for such purposes and approval by the Board of Trustees.

- **Section 5**. The wages and salaries provided for herein shall apply and be paid only to those employees and officers duly appointed and qualified to hold such position or presently employed and whose employment is in good standing as of the date of this Ordinance and shall be in full force and effective as set forth herein retroactive to May 1, 2014, and shall be paid when funds become available for such purpose. Elected Officials shall not receive an increase in annual salary.
- **Section 6.** Any existing positions for which salaries are not stated or provided in this Ordinance shall continue to be compensated at the level of salary as last approved by the Board of Trustees for such positions except in the event of termination of the position or of the employee or reduction in compensation at which time this authorization shall cease.
- **Section 7**. All positions listed above that have an * (asterisks) following the position are hereby designated as exempt employees and as such shall be considered salaried employees and not eligible for overtime compensation.
- Section 8. This Ordinance, and its parts, are declared to be severable and any section, clause, provision, or portion of this Ordinance that is declared invalid shall not affect the validity of any other provision of this Ordinance, which shall remain in full force and effect.
- **Section 9.** All ordinances, resolutions, motions or orders in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
- Section 10. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval to ensure that public services are maintained and the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village is duly protected.

WHEREAS, the Village of Franklin Park, Cook County, Illinois (the "Village") is a duly organized and existing municipal corporation created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois and under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code, as from time to time supplemented and amended; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Franklin Park (the "Corporate Authorities") may from time to time amend the text of the Village Code of Franklin Park when it is determined to be in the best interests of the residents of the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities find it necessary to amend the fees, rates, charges and fines for various services and violations in order to more accurately reflect the overall cost of such services and enforcement procedures.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Franklin Park, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

- Section 1. That the above recitals and legislative findings are found to be true and correct and are hereby incorporated herein and made a part hereof, as if fully set forth in their entirety.
- Section 2. Section 6-3-4 ("Fines for Parking Violations") of Chapter 3 ("Parking Regulations") of Title 6 ("Motor Vehicles and Traffic") of the Village Code of Franklin Park, Illinois, is hereby amended by deleting the following stricken language and adding the underlined

language to read, as follows:

6-3-4. Fines for parking violations.

Unless expressly provided otherwise in a specific provision of this title, the fine for all parking and/or standing violations shall be thirty-five dollars (\$35.00) fifty dollars (\$50.00) if paid within ten (10) days of issuance of the notice of violation or ticket. After ten (10) days, the fine for all parking and/or standing violations shall be fifty dollars (\$50.00).

Section 3. Section 6-3-5 ("Enforcement of Parking Offenses") of Chapter 3 ("Parking Regulations") of Title 6 ("Motor Vehicles and Traffic") of the Village Code of Franklin Park, Illinois, is hereby amended by deleting the following stricken language and adding the underlined language to read, as follows:

6-3-5. Enforcement of parking offenses.

- (i) Schedule of fines/penalties.
 - (1) The fines and penalties which shall be imposed for the violation of vehicular standing, parking, or compliance regulation violations shall be as follows and the fines and penalties herein set forth shall be uniformly applied for each violation of any applicable village ordinance. A late payment penalty shall be assessed for each violation notice that is paid more than ten (10) days after service of the violation notice.

Notwithstanding anything to the contrary herein, any person found liable after a hearing, or after failing to appear for a hearing, for a violation of a parking restriction regarding prohibited fire lane parking shall be fined in an amount not less than one hundred dollars (\$100.00) one hundred fifteen dollars (\$115.00) nor more than two hundred fifty dollars (\$250.00) per offense and any person found liable after a hearing or after failing to appear for a hearing for violating a parking restriction regarding unauthorized parking in a space reserved for persons with disabilities shall be fined in an amount not less than two hundred fifty dollars (\$250.00) two hundred sixty five dollars (\$265.00) nor more than three hundred fifty dollars (\$350.00).
- (3) Notwithstanding anything to the contrary, any person found liable of violating section 3-413(f) of the Illinois Vehicle Code³, expired state registration, shall be fined in an amount not to exceed thirty five dollars (\$35.00) fifty dollars (\$50.00).

6-6I-8. Fines for violations.

The amount of such fine shall be thirty dollars (\$30.00) fifty dollars (\$50.00) for

In the event that it is necessary for a court notice to issue, no lesser fee shall be deemed to satisfy the fine herein established for each such violation upon which such court notice has issued. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary herein, any person found liable after a hearing, or after failing to appear for a hearing, for a violation of a parking regulation shall be fined in an amount not less than fifty dollars (\$50.00) nor more than nor more than two hundred fifty dollars (\$250.00) per offense.

Section 6-6J-6 ("Fines; time of Payment") of Article J ("Franklin Avenue Business District Community Parking Lot") of Chapter 6 ("Traffic Schedules") of Title 6 ("Motor Vehicles and Traffic") of the Village Code of Franklin Park, Illinois, is hereby amended by deleting the following stricken language and adding the underlined language to read, as follows:

6-6J-6. Fines for violations; time of payment.

- Section 2. Section 11-1-1-2 ("Schedule A-2; Activities Regulated by the Fire Department/Fire Marshal") of Chapter 1 ("Fees, Rates and Charges") of Title 11 ("Fees") of the Village Code of Franklin Park is hereby amended by adding the following new underlined language

to read, as follows:

WHEREAS, the Village of Franklin Park, Cook County, Illinois (the "Village") is a duly organized and existing municipal corporation created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois and under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code, as from time to time supplemented and amended; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Franklin Park (the "Corporate Authorities") may from time to time amend the text of the Village Code of Franklin Park when it is determined to be in the best interests of the residents of the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities are charged with the responsibility of reviewing user fees to accurately reflect the overall cost of services and enforcement procedures; and

WHEREAS, the expenses to inspect and administer a flow test as well as the amount of water consumed has increased to the point of requiring an adjustment for the performance of a flow test.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Franklin Park, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

- Section 1. That the above recitals and legislative findings are found to be true and correct and are hereby incorporated herein and made a part hereof, as if fully set forth in their entirety.
- Section 2. Section 7-8B-5 ("Flow Test") of Article B ("Service Charges") of Chapter 8 ("Water Systems") of Title 7 ("Public Works and Properties") of the Village Code of Franklin Park

is hereby amended by deleting the following stricken language and adding the underlined language to read, as follows:

SECTION 7-8B-5. FLOW TEST.

Flow tests of the village water system shall be conducted only by employees of the department of municipal utilities, streets, forestry, water and sewer. Flow test shall be permitted to occur between April 1st to November 30th during normal business hours of the department of municipal utilities, streets, forestry, water and sewer. Flow test during any other time period must be authorized by the utilities commissioner and designee of the fire prevention bureau. A person requesting a flow test shall contact the utilities commissioner and shall pay a twenty five dollar (\$25.00) three hundred and fifty dollar (\$350.00) fee to the village comptroller. If a test takes longer than five (5) minutes, an additional twenty five dollar (\$25.00) fifty dollar (\$50.00) fee shall be paid for each additional five (5) minute period or fraction thereof.

In addition to the payment of the fee, a deposit of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) fifty dollars (\$50.00) shall be paid to the village comptroller, which shall be refunded when the person requesting the flow test has delivered a copy of the result of the test to the utilities commissioner.

- **Section 3**. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any other provision of this Ordinance.
- **Section 4**. All ordinances, resolutions, motions or orders in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

WHEREAS, the location of the Street Dance will require either the partial or complete temporary closure of the following right-of-ways: that portion of Franklin Avenue from 25th Avenue to Ruby Street on Friday, July 24, 2014, at 9:00 a.m. through and until Saturday, July 25, 2015, at 6:00 a.m. (the "Street Dance Street Closure"); and

WHEREAS, the Village President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Franklin Park (the "Corporate Authorities") find it necessary and in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village to permit the Street Dance Street Closure to all non-emergency vehicular traffic in order to permit the Street Dance event to occur.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Franklin Park, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. That the above recitals and legislative findings are found to be true and correct and are hereby incorporated herein and made a part hereof, as if fully set forth in their

entirety.

Section 2. The Street Dance Street Closure, as herein described, is hereby approved and the Village is prepared to assume all responsibility and liability involved in any Street Dance Street Closure, as required by any governmental agencies having jurisdiction thereof, and no further, and that the Utilities Director and Chief of Police are hereby authorized to take such necessary action to undertake the Street Dance Street Closure and to establish such necessary detours over routes that can accept anticipated vehicular traffic, which are conspicuously marked for the benefit of traffic diverted from such right-of-ways.

Section 3. The Utilities Commissioner and the Chief of Police are hereby authorized to restrict the parking of vehicular traffic within and around the Street Dance Street Closure as determined necessary to ensure the public health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village and the Police Chief is hereby authorized to take such necessary action to divert traffic from the Street Dance Street Closure and to provide such force as deemed necessary to direct, protect, and regulate traffic during the time the detours are in effect.

Section 4. The Police Chief is hereby further authorized to provide for the positioning of authorized flaggers at each end of any right-of-way and at other such points as may be necessary to assist in directing traffic through the detour provided that emergency vehicles shall be permitted in emergency situations to pass through the closed area as is safe for all concerned.

Section 5. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any other provision of this Ordinance.
