**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER SIX OF TITLE SIX OF THE VILLAGE
CODE OF THE VILLAGE OF FRANKLIN PARK, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS
(HANDICAPPED RESERVED PARKING SPACE FOR 2842 MAPLE STREET)**

WHEREAS, the Village of Franklin Park, Cook County, Illinois (the "*Village*") is a duly organized and existing municipal corporation created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois and under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code, as from time to time supplemented and amended; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Franklin Park (the "*Corporate Authorities*") may from time to time amend the text of the Village Code of Franklin Park when it is determined to be in the best interests of the residents of the Village; and

WHEREAS, an application for reserved handicapped parking was submitted to the Village by a resident of 2842 Maple Street; and

WHEREAS, the police department has reviewed the above referenced application and upon due investigation is recommending approval of said application to the Corporate Authorities.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Franklin Park, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. That the above recitals are found to be true and correct and are hereby incorporated herein and made a part hereof, as if fully set forth in their entirety.

Section 2. Section 6-6F-8 ("*Reserved Parking Spaces*") of Article F ("*Parking Restrictions*") of Chapter 6 ("*Traffic Schedules*") of Title 6 ("*Motor Vehicles and Traffic*") of the Village Code of Franklin Park is hereby amended by adding the following underlined language to read, as follows:

Section 3. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any other provision of this Ordinance.

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING AN AGREEMENT TO CONTRACT FOR GRASS CUTTING SERVICES FOR PROPERTIES IDENTIFIED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF INSPECTIONAL SERVICES BETWEEN BIUNDO LANDSCAPING AND THE VILLAGE OF FRANKLIN PARK, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, the Village of Franklin Park, Cook County, Illinois (the "*Village*") is a duly organized and existing municipal corporation created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois and under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code, as from time to time supplemented and amended; and

WHEREAS, Biundo Landscaping, located at 3541 Britta Avenue, Franklin Park, Illinois, is in the business of providing grass cutting services; and

WHEREAS, the Village requires such services as part of its 2022 Grass Cutting Enforcement Program (the "*Program*"); and

WHEREAS, Biundo Landscaping and the Village desire to enter into a certain agreement pursuant to which Biundo Landscaping will provide grass cutting services to the Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Franklin Park, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. That the above recitals and legislative findings are found to be true and correct and are hereby incorporated herein and made a part hereof, as if fully set forth in their entirety.

Section 2. The Agreement to Contract for Grass Cutting Services for Properties Identified by the Department of Inspectional Services by and between the Village of Franklin Park, Cook County, Illinois and Biundo Landscaping (the "*Agreement*"), a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof as Exhibit A, is hereby approved substantially in the form presented to

the Village Board, with such necessary changes as may be authorized by the Village President, the execution thereof to constitute the approval by the Village of any and all changes or revisions therein contained.

Section 3. The officials, officers, employees and attorneys of the Village are hereby authorized to take such further actions as are necessary to carry out the intent and purpose of this Ordinance and the Agreement.

Section 4. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any other provision of this Ordinance.

Section 5. All ordinances, resolutions, motions or orders in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 6. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.

**AN ORDINANCE APPROVING A SUBDIVISION OF THE PROPERTY COMMONLY
KNOWN AS 10431 CROWN ROAD AND 10468 CROWN ROAD, FRANKLIN PARK,
COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS
(ZBA: 22-01)**

WHEREAS, the Village of Franklin Park, Cook County, Illinois (the "*Village*") is a duly organized and existing municipal corporation created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois and under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code, as from time to time supplemented and amended; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Franklin Park (the "*Corporate Authorities*") have heretofore exercised the power conferred on them pursuant to Chapter 11-13-1, *et seq.*, of the Illinois Municipal Code by adopting the Franklin Park Zoning Ordinance in 1974 (Ord. 7475 Z10), as amended from time to time; and

WHEREAS, a subdivision application, ZBA 22-01, has been submitted by the Village (the "*Applicant*") requesting approval of a Subdivision of Property, as attached hereto as Exhibit A (the "*Plat of Subdivision*"), for the property commonly known as 10431 Crown Road and 10468 Crown Road, Franklin Park, Illinois, and legally described as set forth in the Plat of Subdivision (the "*Property*"); and

WHEREAS, the Zoning Board of Appeals held a public hearing on March 2, 2022 on whether the Plat of Subdivision should be approved, at which time all persons present were afforded an opportunity to be heard; and

WHEREAS, a public notice in the form required by law was given of said public hearing date by publication not more than thirty (30) days nor less than fifteen (15) days prior to said public

hearing date in the Chicago Tribune, a newspaper of general circulation published in this Village;
and

WHEREAS, the Zoning Board of Appeals has filed its findings of fact and recommendations that the Plat of Subdivision be granted, and the Corporate Authorities have duly considered said findings of fact and recommendations; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities have determined, in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village, to grant the Plat of Subdivision subject to the conditions identified herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Franklin Park, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. The above recitals and legislative findings are found to be true and correct and are hereby incorporated herein and made a part hereof, as if fully set forth in their entirety.

Section 2. The President and the Board of Trustees hereby adopt by reference the findings of fact of the Zoning Board of Appeals as findings of the President and the Board of Trustees as if completely set forth herein. All documents and exhibits submitted at the aforesaid public hearings are also incorporated by reference into this Ordinance.

Section 3. The Corporate Authorities find and determine that the adoption of the Plat of Subdivision is in the public interest and is in furtherance of the progressive demands of orderly Village development.

Section 4. The Plat of Subdivision for the “*Grand-Mannheim Subdivision*”, a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof as Exhibit A, is hereby authorized and approved.

Section 5. The Applicant shall provide the Village the final Plat of Subdivision to the

Village for execution and its subsequent recording.

Section 6. The officials, officers, employees, engineers, and attorneys of the Village are hereby authorized to take any such actions required on the part of the Village to execute and ensure the recording of the final Plat of Subdivision with the County of Cook.

Section 7. If any section, paragraph, clause, or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any other provision of this Ordinance.

Section 8. All ordinances, resolutions, motions, or orders in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 9. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in the manner provided by law.

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF FRANKLIN PARK, COOK COUNTY,
ILLINOIS, GRANTING A CONDITIONAL USE TO ALLOW FOR A “HOTEL” USE
WITHIN THE C-3 GENERAL COMMERCIAL DISTRICT
(ZBA 22-04: 3001 MANNHEIM ROAD)**

WHEREAS, the Village of Franklin Park, Cook County, Illinois (the “*Village*”) is a duly organized and existing municipal corporation created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois and under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code, as from time to time supplemented and amended; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Franklin Park (the “*Corporate Authorities*”) have heretofore exercised the power conferred on them pursuant to Chapter 11-13-1, *et seq.*, of the Illinois Municipal Code by adopting the Franklin Park Zoning Ordinance in 1974 (Ord. 7475 Z-10), as amended from time to time; and

WHEREAS, a conditional use application, ZBA 22-04, has been submitted to the Village by Pushpakkumar Panchal, d/b/a Best Western Plus and Shreeganpatidada, LLC, as owners, (collectively the “*Applicant*”) to allow within the C-3 General Commercial District a “hotel” use (the “*Conditional Use*”) on the property commonly known as 3001 Mannheim Road, Franklin Park, Illinois and as legally described and depicted on Exhibit A (the “*Property*”); and

WHEREAS, the Zoning Board of Appeals held a public hearing on March 2, 2022 on whether the Conditional Use should be approved, at which time all persons present were afforded an opportunity to be heard; and

WHEREAS, a public notice in the form required by law was given of said public hearing date; and

WHEREAS, the Zoning Board of Appeals has filed its findings of fact and recommendations that the Conditional Use be granted, and the Corporate Authorities have duly considered said findings of fact and recommendations; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities have determined, in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village, to grant the Conditional Use subject to the conditions identified herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Franklin Park, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. The above recitals and legislative findings are found to be true and correct and are hereby incorporated herein and made a part hereof, as if fully set forth in their entirety.

Section 2. The President and Board of Trustees hereby adopt by reference the findings of fact of the Zoning Board of Appeals as findings of the President and the Board of Trustees as if completely set forth herein. All documents and exhibits submitted at the aforesaid public hearings are also incorporated by reference into this Ordinance.

Section 3. In addition to the findings set forth in Section 2 hereof, the President and the Board of Trustees further find in relation to the Conditional Use as follows:

1. The establishment, maintenance, or operation of the Conditional Use, subject to the conditions set forth herein, will not be detrimental to, or endanger the public health, safety, morals, comfort, or general welfare;
2. The Conditional Use, subject to the conditions set forth herein, will not be injurious to the use and enjoyment of other property in the immediate vicinity for the purposes already permitted, nor substantially diminish and impair property values within the neighborhood;

3. The Conditional Use, subject to the conditions set forth herein, will not impede the normal and orderly development of the surrounding property for uses permitted in the C-3 General Commercial District;
4. The Conditional Use, subject to the conditions set forth herein, will not affect the exterior architectural appeal and functional plan of structures already constructed as to cause a substantial depreciation in property values within the neighborhood as the proposed plans will be an improvement upon the existing structure;
5. Adequate utilities, access roads, drainage and necessary facilities for the Conditional Use are already in place at the Property;
6. Ingress and egress for the Conditional Use, subject to the conditions set forth herein, shall minimally affect traffic congestion on the public streets; and
7. The Conditional Use shall, in all other respects, conform to the applicable regulations of the C-3 General Commercial District, except as such regulations may, in each instance, be modified by the Board of Trustees pursuant to the recommendations of the Zoning Board of Appeals.

Section 4. The Conditional Use, subject to the conditions set forth below, are hereby granted and issued for a “hotel” use in the C-3 General Commercial District located at 3001 Mannheim Road, Franklin Park, Illinois, and as legally described on Exhibit A.

This Conditional Use is subject to the following conditions:

1. That the applicant does not park vehicles overnight for individuals who are not staying at the hotel for at least one night;
2. That the applicant maintains the existing eight-foot solid screening along the rear alley on the subject property’s eastern boundary;
3. That the applicant completes all work to the subject property, including but not limited to greenspace buffering, parking lot improvements, access drives, trees and landscaping enhancements, and lighting as outlined on the attached site plan within six months after approval from the Board of Trustees;
4. That the applicant reimburses the Village for costs related to tree removal and replacement during the installation of the driveway access onto Schiller Boulevard; and

5. That this Conditional Use complies with all Village ordinances and regulations at all times.

Section 5. The Applicant hereunder shall at all times comply with all Village regulations and the terms and conditions of the Conditional Use and in the event of non-compliance, said permit shall be subject to revocation by appropriate legal proceedings.

Section 6. If any section, paragraph, clause, or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any other provision of this Ordinance.

Section 7. All ordinances, resolutions, motions, or orders in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 8. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect following its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
