

WHEREAS, the Village of Franklin Park, Cook County, Illinois (the "Village") is a duly organized and existing municipal corporation created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois and under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code, as from time to time supplemented and amended; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Commissioners of the County of Cook have enacted an ordinance known as the Cook County Real Property Assessment Classification Ordinance, as amended from time to time (the "Classification Ordinance"), which provides for a tax assessment incentive classification designed to encourage industrial development throughout Cook County by offering a real estate tax incentive for the development of new industrial facilities, the rehabilitation of existing industrial structures and the utilization of abandoned industrial buildings in order to create employment opportunities and expand the tax base; and

WHEREAS, Panattoni Development Company, Incorporated (the "Applicant") is the contract purchaser of a certain parcel of industrial property commonly known as 11601 Copenhagen Court, Franklin Park, Illinois, and hereinafter legally described on Exhibit A, a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof (the "Property"); and

WHEREAS, to ensure the ongoing viability of the industrial base of the Village, the continuation and expansion of employment opportunities in the Village and to safeguard and further diversify the tax base of the Village, the Corporate Authorities have determined that it is necessary and in the best interests of the Village to approve the application by Applicant for a Class 6B Real Estate Tax Assessment Classification for the Property.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Franklin Park, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. That the above recitals and legislative findings are found to be true and correct and are hereby incorporated herein and made a part hereof, as if fully set forth in their entirety.

- Section 2. Subject to the condition set forth in Section 4, the Corporate Authorities expressly support and consent to the filing of an application for a Cook County 6B Tax Assessment Classification for the Property, which is legally described on Exhibit A, and find that without a Class 6B Tax Assessment Classification, the Property will remain vacant and underutilized, which will hinder further development efforts in the area surrounding the Property and will thwart the efforts of Applicant to undertake its proposed development within the Village.
- Section 3. The Corporate Authorities further find that the grant of the Class 6B Tax Assessment Classification is necessary for the industrial development to remain viable on the Property, which is the subject of this Resolution.
- Section 4. WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Franklin Park (the "Corporate Authorities") may from time to time amend the text of the Village Code of Franklin Park when it is determined to be in the best interests of the residents of the Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Franklin Park, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. That the above recitals are found to be true and correct and are hereby incorporated herein and made a part hereof, as if fully set forth in their entirety.

Section 2. Section 7-1-1-1 ("Block Party Regulations") of Chapter 1 ("Streets, Sidewalks and Other Public Property") of Title 7 ("Public Works and Properties") of the Village Code of Franklin Park is hereby amended by deleting the following stricken language and adding the underlined language to read, as follows:

#### 7-1-1. - Block party regulations.

- (a) Permit required. No person or persons shall host, maintain or run a block party without applying for and receiving a block party permit from the village. Block party applications shall be furnished by the village clerk's office.
- (b) Regulations. Upon completion of a block party application, the village clerk's office shall issue a no fee permit subject to the following regulations:

- (1) A permit shall be granted upon receipt by the village of a petition signed by at least sixty (60) percent of the residents in the block requesting permission to hold a block party. All petitions and applications shall be delivered to the village clerk's office at least thirty (30) days prior to the scheduled date of the block party.
- Block parties shall be permitted from twelve o'clock (12:00) noon to eleven ten o'clock (11:00 10:00) P.M. and no streets shall be blocked prior to twelve o'clock (12:00) noon or after eleven ten o'clock (11:00 10:00) P.M. on the date of the block party.
- (3) All music produced by electrical or mechanical means or by live musicians shall be kept at a noise level acceptable to the residents of the block and shall not be so loud as to disturb residents of adjoining blocks.
- (4) All barricades used to block the street will be furnished by the village. Barricades will be picked up by the homeowner designated on the application and will be picked up from the homeowner by the village on the next scheduled workday after the block party. The designated homeowner shall bear full responsibility ensuring that no damage occurs to the barricades.
- (5) Cars shall not be permitted to block the entrance to the street. Violators shall be subject to citation and towing of the vehicles.
- (6) An area in the center of all streets, wide enough for emergency vehicles, shall be kept clear of all items in order to permit emergency vehicles to pass through at all times.
- (7) No fee shall be charged for admission to a block party.
- Section 3. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any other provision of this Ordinance.

WHEREAS, the Village of Franklin Park, Cook County, Illinois (the "Village") is a duly organized and existing municipal corporation created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois and under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code, as from time to time supplemented and amended; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Franklin Park (the "Corporate Authorities") may from time to time amend the text of the Village Code of Franklin Park when it is determined to be in the best interests of the residents of the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities find that it is in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of its citizenry to amend the regulations concerning parking in the Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Franklin Park, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. That the above recitals are found to be true and correct and are hereby incorporated herein and made a part hereof, as if fully set forth in their entirety.

Section 2. Section 6-6F-1 ("Parking Prohibited in Certain Places or Zones") of Article F ("Parking Restrictions") of Chapter 6 ("Traffic Schedules") of Title 6 ("Motor Vehicles and Traffic") of the Village Code of Franklin Park is hereby amended by adding the following underlined language to read, as follows:

Street	Side	Area
Carnation Street	Both sides	From Seymour Avenue south to Waveland Avenue
Centrella Street	Both sides	From Seymour Avenue south to Waveland Avenue

**Section 3.** If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any other provision of this Ordinance.

Section 4. All ordinances, resolutions, motions or orders in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
