WHEREAS, the Village of Franklin Park, Cook County, Illinois (the "Village") is a duly organized and existing municipal corporation created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois and under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code, as from time to time supplemented and amended.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Franklin Park, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. That the above recital is hereby incorporated herein and made a part hereof, as if fully set forth in its entirety.

Section 2. The Construction Engineering Services Agreement for Federal Participation for Phase Three Construction Engineering Services for the Franklin Avenue Reconstruction Project by and between Christopher Burke Engineering, Ltd., and the Village of Franklin Park, Cook County, Illinois (the "Agreement"), a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof as Exhibit A, is hereby approved in substantially the form presented to the Village Board, with such necessary changes as may be authorized by the Village President, the execution thereof to constitute the approval by the Village of any and all changes or revisions therein contained.

Section 3. The officials, officers, employees, engineers, and attorneys of the Village are hereby authorized to take such further actions as are necessary to carry out the intent and

purpose of this Ordinance and the Agreement.

- Section 4. If any section, paragraph, clause, or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any other provision of this Ordinance.
- Section 5. All ordinances, resolutions, motions, or orders in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
- Section 6. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
