SFPFD Smolen delivered a Grant acceptance speech at Morton Arboretum.
- 5. Additional hours have been granted by the Police department for the seminar. It will begin at 1 to 4 p.m. on Oct 12, with a 2 hour set-up window at 11 a.m.
